Praznyk Liturgical Guidelines

- The Bishop is greeted in front of the church (at the door) with bread & salt and with flowers.
- Pastor presents Bishop with a hand cross for the procession into the church. After greeting (still at the doors):

Pastor: May the Lord bless you from Zion, and may you know Jerusalem's blessings all the days of your life, always, now, and forever.

All: Amen.

Blessed be the name of the Lord, always, now and forever.

The Bishop taking the Trikirion & Dikirion (in the sanctuary before the Divine Liturgy):

Bishop: O Lord, Lord, ... All: Mnohaya Lita, Lita. Многая літа, літа.

Troparion, tone 4: When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel* the glorious news of the resurrection* and cast off the ancestral condemnation,* they proudly told the apostles:* "Death has been plundered!* Christ our God is risen,* granting to the world great mercy."

Feast-day Troparion, *Tone 1:* O Mother of God, in giving birth you still preserved virginity, and in your falling asleep you did not forsake the world. You are the Mother of Life and have been transferred to life, and through your prayers have delivered our souls from death.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, tone 3: Today we revere the star of Rus', blessed Theodosius, * who shone from the east and same to the West;* for he enriched this whole land and all of us* with gentleness and miraculous wonders* by the practice and the grace of the monastic rule.

Now and for ever and ever.

Feast-day Kontakion, tone 2: The grave and death did not detain the Mother of God. * She prays perpetually and is our unfailing hope of intercession, * for He who

dwelt in the womb of the everlasting Virgin * transferred to life the Mother of Life.

The Trisagion

After second "Holy God", clergy sing: "Hagios ho Theos, hagios iskhiros, hagios athanatos, eleison himas".

- Priest: Give glory to Christ, our God! *** Віддайте славу Христу Богові нашому!
- All: continue the Trisagion with "Glory be to the Father...

Prokeimenon, Tone 3: My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Saviour.

verse: Because He has regarded the humility of His handmaid; for behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. (Luke 1:46-48)

Prokeimenon, Tone 7: Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His venerable ones. (Psalm 115:15)

Апостол: (Флп 2,5-11)

Браття і Сестри, плекайте ті самі думки в собі, які були й у Христі Ісусі. Він, існуючи в Божій природі, не вважав за здобич свою рівність із Богом, а применшив себе самого, прийнявши вигляд слуги, ставши подібним до людини. Epistle: A reading from the Letter of the Holy Apostle Paul to the Philippians (Phil. 2:5-11):

Brothers and Sisters, let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited, but emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. And being found in human form, he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death— even death on a cross. Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Alleluia, Tone 8: Rise up, O Lord, to the place of Your rest, You and the ark of Your holiness.

verse: The Lord swore an oath to David, and will not go back on His word.



Gospel: Luke 10:38-42, 11:27-28

At that time. Jesus entered a certain village, where a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. She had a sister named Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to what he was saying. But Martha was distracted by her many tasks; so she came to him and asked, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Tell her then to help me." But the Lord answered her, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and distracted by many things; there is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her." While he was saying this, a woman in the crowd raised her voice and said to him, "Blessed is the womb that bore you and the breasts that nursed you!" But he said, "Blessed rather are those who hear the word of God and obey it!"

After the Gospel reading:

All: Glory be to You, O Lord, glory be to You.

The Bishop will bless the faithful with candles and all sing the "Mnohaya Lita".

After Great Entrance

Bishop will bless the faithful with candles and all sing "Mnohaya Lita."

Anaphora

After: "The mercy of peace, the sacrifice of praise", the Bishop blesses with the candles. **NO** "Mnohaya Lita" at this point.

Hymn to the Mother of God - Seeing the Dormition of the Most Pure One, the angels were filled with awe at how the Virgin went from earth to Heaven.

Irmos: In you, O pure Virgin, the laws of nature were overcome: in giving birth you remained a virgin, and in your death heralded life. You remained a virgin after giving birth and remained alive after death, always saving your descendants, O Mother of God.

Communion Hymn - I will take the chalice of salvation;* and I will call upon the name of the Lord.* Alleluia, alleluia,* alleluia. (Psalm 115:13)

Thanksgiving Hymn

After Holy Communion the Bishop blesses the people with the chalice saying: "Save Your people..."

All respond: *Ha Многая літа, Владико*. (Na Mnohaya Lita, Vladyko), OR May God grant You many years Bishop Ken. "We have seen the true light…"

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion:

- 1. You are a member of the Catholic Church (Orthodox faithful are welcome to receive Communion);
- 2. You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently;
- 3. You attend Divine Services regularly;
- 4. Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church;
- 5. You have kept the Liturgical fast no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water & medicine does not break the fast).
- 6. You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel.
- 7. To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace.

 If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.
- **A Reminder about appropriate reception of Holy Communion when approaching to receive the Holy Eucharist, the faithful are reminded to open their mouth wide and tilt their head back. Also, please avoid licking the spoon. **
