Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians: (Gal. 4:4-7)

Brothers and Sisters, when the designated time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to deliver from the law those who were subjected to it, so that we might receive our status as adopted children. The proof that you are children is the fact that God has sent forth into our hearts the Spirit of his Son which cries out "Abba! Father!" You are no longer a slave but a child! And the fact that you are a child makes you an heir, by God's design.



Alleluia (Tone 1): The heavens tell the glory of God, and the firmament declares the work of His hands (Ps 18:2). Day announces its message unto day and night proclaims its knowledge unto night (Ps 18:3).

Gospel: (Mathew 2:1-12)

After Jesus' birth in Bethlehem of Judea during the reign of King Herod, astrologers from the east arrived one day in Jerusalem inquiring, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We observed his star at its rising and have come to pay him homage." At this news King Herod became greatly disturbed, and with him all Jerusalem. Summoning all of the chief priests and scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Messiah was to be born. "In Bethlehem of Judea," they informed him. "Here is what the prophet has written: 'And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the princess of Judah, since from you shall come a ruler who is to shepherd my people Israel.'"

Herod called the astrologers aside and found out from them the exact time of the star's appearance. Then he sent them to Bethlehem, after having instructed them: "Go and get detailed information about the child. When you have found him, report it to me so that I may go and offer him homage too." After their audience the king, they set out. The star which they have observed at its rising went ahead of them until it came to a standstill over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house, found the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then, they opened their coffers and presented him with gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. They received a message in a dream not to return to Herod, so they went back to their own country by another route.

Instead of "It is truly...": O my soul, magnify Christ the King born in a manger.

Irmos (Tone 1): A strange and glorious mystery do I behold: the cave is heaven; the Virgin, the throne of the cherubim; the manger, a dwelling place in which is laid Christ, the God Whom nothing can contain. Singing His praises, we glorify Him.

Communion Verse: The Lord has sent deliverance to His people (Ps 110:9). Alleluia! (3x)

Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

<u>Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry:</u> Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment.

Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time, **Holy Unction** (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time), **Funerals and Memorials**: by appointment.

PASTORAL LETTER

FROM THE UKRAINIAN CATHOLIC BISHOPS OF CANADA ON THE OCCASION OF THE NATIVITY OF OUR LORD 2020-2021 A.D.

To the Reverend Clergy, Monastics, Seminarians and Laity of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada:

Christ is Born! Let Us Glorify Him!

Dearly Beloved in Christ!

"Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you." Lk 1:28

With what mixed emotions did the Mother of God experience the Annunciation when the Archangel Gabriel greeted Her? On one hand, She experienced fear and confusion about what was taking place in Her life: physically - bearing Jesus in her womb while not yet married; and spiritually - being filled with the Holy Spirit and overwhelmed with peace and joy! Nine months later, at the birth of Her Son Jesus, She continued to treasure and ponder all these words in Her heart. And now, as we celebrate the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ we might ask ourselves what we are pondering in our hearts? For the past nine months, how have we been pondering the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives and the presence of Jesus, indeed, the Trinity dwelling in us?

Understandably, it was painful for Mary, when some ridiculed Her as a maiden with child. Meanwhile, others rejoiced with Her, such as her cousin Elizabeth. How important it must have been for Mary to have faith in God's presence so that She

was able to face all storms in life with a deep conviction of His love. Similarly, be mindful of how important it is for all of us today to be certain of God's presence for He walks with us through the tragedies in life and is ever ready to celebrate times of joy with us. Either way, He accompanies us doing the will of the Father.

We must pray for the same assurance the Mother of God had at that time. Let us draw strength from Her example of faith and trust in God. She gave birth to Jesus and raised Him, sharing His Sacred Heart with others through Her Heart. We strive to do the same, and pray for those in our families who long for a deep confidence in knowing they are loved and not alone during these difficult times. The challenges we face as individuals, as families and communities are numerous, and we need to be reminded that God is with us in our challenges. Jesus is the true vine, and "every branch that bears fruit, he prunes to make it bear more fruit" (Jn15:2 NRSV).

Therefore, while growing weary of COVID and all the adjustments to life we are making, let us remain connected to our parish family. Let us celebrate our faith by knowing the presence of God in Holy Scripture. We are part of the vine. Remain in God through the Eucharist either physically or through spiritual communion. Prepare to celebrate Reconciliation sacramentally as we forgive one another on a daily basis. Then, renewed in Christ, let us follow Him as Missionary Disciples to minister to those who feel isolated and alone: in Canada, Ukraine or wherever our loved ones struggle. Celebrate the birth of Christ by being Christ for others! God has given us the grace to make sure others don't feel alone despite physical distancing and much more difficult circumstances. Jesus fulfills Scripture through us when we realize more deeply that He dwells within us, helping others believe, sing and proclaim, "God is With Us, Understand This All You Nations! And Be Humbled, For God Is With Us!"

May our celebration of this profound truth this Christmas be a time to encounter Jesus Christ in our spouse, in our family members and in our parish because we are an essential part of this profound truth. May we be aware of the presence of Jesus, Mary and Joseph that give us the gift of the Holy Family which is present in our personal and parish families. And may this awareness bear fruit in our lives throughout the new year, 2021, and beyond.

Христос Рождається! Славімо Його!

Дорогі в Христі!

«Радуйся, благодатна! Господь з тобою!» (Лк. 1,28)

Які мала Богородиця змішані емоції під час Благовіщення, коли її привітав архангел Гавриїл? З одного боку, вона відчувала страх і розгубленість, що стосується всього того, що відбувалося в її житті: фізично - як носила Ісуса в своєму лоні, коли вона ще чоловіка не знала; та духовно - хоч сповнена Святим Духом, її охопили мир та радість! Після дев'яти місяців, при народженні її Сина Ісуса, вона продовжувала зберігати й обмірковувати всі ці слова у своєму серці. І тепер, коли ми святкуємо різдво Господа і Спасителя нашого Ісуса Христа, ми можемо запитати себе, про що ми розмірковуємо у нашому серці? Протягом останніх дев'яти місяців, як ми розмірковували над діяльністю Святого Духа у нашому житті та над присутністю Ісуса, а й Тройці, що перебуває у нас?

Зрозуміло, що Марії було боляче, коли деякі висміювали її як дівчину, яка мала дитину. Тим часом інші раділи їй, так як це зробила її родичка Єлизавета. Як важливо для Марії було вірити в присутність Бога, щоб Вона могла протистояти всім життєвим бурям з глибоким переконанням у Його любові. Подібно, пам'ятайте, як важливо для всіх нас сьогодні мати певність, що Бог присутній, тому що Він проходить разом із нами через усі життєві трагедії та завжди готовий святкувати разом із нами всі радісні хвилини. У будь-якому випадку, Він супроводжує нас, виконуючи волю Отця.

Ми повинні молитися за ту саму певність, яку Богородиця в той час мала. Черпаймо силу з її прикладу віри та довіри до Бога. Вона народила Ісуса і виховувала Його, ділячись Його Пресвятим Серцем з іншими через її серце. Ми прагнемо робити те саме і молимось за тих, які в наших родинах прагнуть глибокої сміливості, знаючи, що хтось їх любить, що вони не самотні в ці важкі часи. Викликів, з якими ми стикаємось як окремі люди, як родини та

громади, дуже багато, і потрібно нам пам'ятати, що з нами Бог серед наших викликів. Ісус є справжньою виноградною лозою, а «кожну галузку, яка родить плід, очищає, щоб рясніше родила» (Ів. 15,2).

Тому, поступово втомлюючись від коронавірусної хвороби COVID-19 та всіх зазнаних змін у нашому житті, залишаймося зв'язані з нашою парафіяльною родиною. Святкуймо нашу віру, знаючи присутність Бога у Святому Письмі. Ви є частиною лози. Перебувайте в Бозі через Євхаристію фізично або через духовне Святе Причастя. Приготуйтеся для звершення Таїнства Примирення таїнственно (сакраментально), коли ми щодня прощаємо одне одному. Тоді, оновлені у Христі, слідуймо за Ним як учні-місіонери, щоб послужити тим, які відчувають себе ізольованими та самотніми: у Канаді, в Україні чи там, де наші близькі борються. Святкуйте різдво Христа, будучи Христом для інших! Бог дав нам ласку подбати про те, щоб інші не відчували себе самотніми, незважаючи на фізичну дистанцію та набагато складніші обставини. Ісус сповнює Писання через нас, коли ми глибше усвідомлюємо, що Він живе у нас, допомагаючи іншим вірити, співати і проголошувати: «З нами Бог, розумійте, народи! І покоряйтеся, бо з нами Бог! "

Нехай цього Різдва наше святкування цієї глибокої істини стане часом зустрічі з Ісусом Христом в одного з подругів, у членах нашої родини та в нашій парафії, оскільки ми є важливою частиною цієї глибокої істини. Будьмо свідомі, що Ісус, Марія та Йосиф є поруч з нами та дарують нам Пресвяту Родину, яка є присутньою у наших особистих та парафіяльних родинах. І нехай це усвідомлення принесе плід у нашому житті протягом Нового 2021-го Року та майбутніх років.
