#### **Epistle:** A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians: (Gal. 1:11-19)

Brothers and Sisters, I assure you, the gospel I proclaimed to you is no mere human invention. I did not receive it from any man, nor was schooled in it. It came by revelation from Jesus Christ. You have heard, I know, the story of my former way of life in Judaism. You know that I went to extremes in persecuting the Church of God and tried to destroy it; I made progress in Jewish observance far beyond most of my contemporaries, in my excess of zeal to live out all the traditions of my ancestors.

But the time came when he who had set me apart before I was born and called me by his favor chose to reveal his Son to me, that I might spread among the Gentiles the good tidings concerning him. Immediately, without seeking human advisers or even going to Jerusalem to see those who were apostles before me, I went off to Arabia later I returned to Damascus. Three years after that I went up to Jerusalem to get to know Cephas, with whom I stayed fifteen days. I did not meet any other apostles except James, the brother of the Lord.

**Alleluia** (tone 4): Lord, remember David and all his meekness. (Psalm 131:1) How he swore an oath to the Lord, and vowed to the God of Jacob. (Psalm 131:2) **Gospel**: (Matthew 2:13-23)

When the wise men had left, an angel of the Lord suddenly appeared in a dream to Joseph with the command: "Get up, take the child and his mother, and flee to Egypt. Stay there until I tell you otherwise. Herod is searching for the child to destroy him." Joseph got up and took the child and his mother and left that night for Egypt. He stayed there until the death of Herod, to fulfill what the Lord said through the prophet: "Out of Egypt I have called my son."

Once Herod realized that he had been deceived by the astrologers, he became furious. He ordered the massacre of all the boys two years old and under in Bethlehem and its environs, making his calculations on the basis of the date he had learned from the astrologers. What was said through Jeremiah the prophet was then fulfilled: "A cry was heard at Ramah, sobbing and loud lamentation: Rachel bewailing her children; no comfort for her, since they are no more."

But after Herod's death, the angel of the Lord appeared in a dream to Joseph in Egypt with the command: "Get up, take the child and his mother, and set out for the land of Israel. Those who had designs on the life of the child are dead." He got up, took the child and his mother, and returned to the land of Israel. He heard, however, that Archelaus had succeeded his father Herod as king of Judea, and he was afraid to go back there. Instead, because of a warning received in a dream, Joseph went to the region of Galilee. There he settled in a town called Nazareth. In this way what was said through the prophets was fulfilled: "He shall be called a Nazorean."

Hymn to the Mother of God: O my soul, magnify Christ the King born in a manger.

At the conclusion of every Divine Liturgy, we say an additional prayer for peace in Ukraine until the end of the war and for peace in the World: Our Father ... Hail Mary ... Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.



#### <u>Апостол</u>: До Галатів послання Святого Апостола Павла читання: (Гл. 1, 11-19)

Браття та Сестри, сповіщаю вам, що Євангеліє, яке я вам проповідував, не від людей; бо ж я його не прийняв, ні навчився від людини, а через об'явлення Ісуса Христа. Ви чули про мою поведінку колись у юдействі, про те, що я жорстоко переслідував Церкву Божу та руйнував її. Я визначався серед багатьох ровесників з мого роду, бувши запеклим прихильником передань моїх предків. Та коли Той, хто вибрав мене вже від утроби моєї матері і покликав Своєю благодаттю, зволив об'явити в мені Сина Свого, щоб я проповідував Його між поганами, я негайно, ні з ким не радившись, не пішов у Єрусалим до тих, що були апостолами передо мною, але пішов в Арабію і потім повернувся в Дамаск. Три роки після того пішов я в Єрусалим відвідати Петра. Іншого з апостолів я не бачив, крім Якова, брата Господнього.

**Алилуя** *(глас 4)*: Пом'яни, Господи, Давида і всю кротость його (Пс 131, 1). Бо клявся він Господеві, обіцявся Богові Якова (Пс. 131,2). <u>Євангеліє</u>: *(Мт. 2,13-23)* 

Коли відійшли мудреці, то ангел Господній у сні явився Йосифові, кажучи: Встань, візьми дитя і матір Його, і втікай в Єгипет, і будь там, поки скажу тобі, бо Ірод хоче шукати дитя, щоб погубити Його. А він, вставши, взяв дитя та матір Його вночі і відійшов у Єгипет. І був там до смерти Іродової, щоб збулося сказане від Господа пророком, що говорив: 3 Єгипту визвав Я сина Мого. Тоді Ірод, побачивши, що був поруганий волхвами, розгнівався дуже і післав повбивати всіх дітей, що були у Вифлеємі і всіх околицях його, від двох років і нижче, згідно з часом, про який докладно розпитав у мудреців. Тоді збулося сказане Єремією пророком, що говорить: Голос в Рамі чути було, плач і ридання і голосіння велике. Рахиль — оплакуюча дітей своїх: і не хотіла утішитися, бо їх немає. І коли помер Ірод, то ангел Господень у сні явився Йосифові в Єгипті, кажучи: Встань, візьми дитя і матір Його і йди в землю Ізраїлеву, бо вимерли ті, що шукали душі дитяти. А він, вставши, взяв дитя і матір Його і прийшов в землю Ізраїлеву. Та почувши, що Архилай царює в Юдеї замість Ірода, батька свого, побоявся туди йти, а прийнявши вість у сні, відійшов в сторони галилейські. І прийшовши, поселився в городі, званім Назарет, щоб збулося сказане пророками, що Назарянином назветься.

Замість Достойно: Величай, душе моя, у вертепі народженого Царя – Христа.

**Ірмос** (глас 1): Таїнство чудне бачу і преславне: небо – вертеп, престол херувимський – Діву, ясла – вмістилище, в яких возліг невмістимий Христос Бог. Його оспівуючи величаємо.

**Причасні:** Хваліте Господа з небес,\* хваліте Його на висотах (Пс. 148,1). Радуйтеся, праведні, у Господі, правим належить похвала (Пс. 32,1). **Алилуя** (х3).

If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

<u>Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry:</u> Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment.

**Holy Communion**: for the sick, by appointment, any time, **Holy Unction** (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time), **Funerals and Memorials**: by appointment.

## SOLEMNITY OF THE LORD'S CHRISTMAS



#### HOMILY OF THE HOLY FATHER FRANCIS

Vatican Basilica Thursday, 24 December 2020 A.D

On this night the great prophecy of Isaiah is fulfilled: "A child is born for us, a son has been given to us" (*Is* 9,5).

We have been given a son. It is often said that the greatest joy in life is the birth of a child. It is something extraordinary, which changes everything, sets in motion unexpected energies and overcomes fatigue, discomfort and sleepless waking, because it brings great happiness, in front of which nothing seems to weigh. This is how Christmas is: the birth of Jesus is the novelty that allows us to be reborn within each year, to find in Him the strength

to face every trial. Yes, because his birth is for us: for me, for you, for all of us, for each one. *For* is the word that returns on this holy night: "A child is born *for us*", Isaiah prophesied; "Today the Savior is born *for us*", we repeated in the Psalm; Jesus "gave himself up *for us*" (*Tit* 2:14), St. Paul proclaimed; and the angel in the Gospel announced: "Today a Savior is born *for you*" (*Lk* 2:11). For me, for you.

But what does this want to tell us *for us*? That the Son of God, the blessed by nature, comes to make us blessed children by grace. Yes, God comes into the world as a son to make us children of God. What a wonderful gift! Today God amazes us and says to each of us: "You are a marvel". Sister, brother, don't lose heart. Are you tempted to feel wrong? God tells you: "No, you are *my* son!" You have the feeling of not making it, the fear of being inadequate, the fear of not getting out of the *tunnel* of the test? God tells you: "Courage, I'm with you". He does not say it to you in words, but by making himself a son like you and for you, to remind you of the starting point of all your rebirth: recognizing yourself as a son of God, daughter of God. This is the starting point of any rebirth. This is the indestructible heart of our hope, the incandescent core that sustains existence: beneath our qualities and our defects, stronger than the wounds and failures of the past, the fears and anxiety for the future, c 'is this truth: we are beloved children. And God's love for us does not and will never depend on us: it is *free love*. This night finds no explanation elsewhere: only grace. Everything is grace. The gift is free, without the merit of each of us, pure grace. Tonight, Saint Paul told us, "the grace of God appeared" (*Tit* 2:11). Nothing is more precious.

We have been given a son. The Father did not give us something, but his own only begotten Son, who is all his joy. Yet, if we look at man's ingratitude towards God and injustice towards so many of our brothers, a doubt arises: did the Lord do well to give us so much, is it right to still have faith in us? Don't you overestimate us? Yes, he overestimates us, and he does it because he loves us to death. He can't help but love us. He is like that, he is so different from us. He always loves us, more good than we manage to have for ourselves. It is his secret to enter our heart. God knows that the only way to save us, to heal ourselves inside, is to love us: there is no other way. He knows that we only improve by welcoming his *tireless love*, which does not change, but changes us. Only the love of Jesus transforms life, heals the deepest wounds, frees us from the vicious circles of dissatisfaction, anger and complaint.


We have been given a son. In the poor manger of a dark stable there is precisely the Son of God. Another question arises: why did he come to light in the night, without a worthy lodging, in poverty and rejection, when he deserved to be born as the greatest king in the most beautiful of buildings? Because? To make us understand how far our human condition loves: to the point of touching with his *concrete love*our worst misery. The Son of God was born discarded to tell us that every discarded person is a child of God. He came into the world as a child comes into the world, weak and fragile, so that we can accept our weaknesses with tenderness. And to discover an important thing: as in Bethlehem, so also with us God loves to do great things through our poverty. He has put all our salvation in the manger of a stable and does not fear our poverty: let us allow his mercy to transform our miseries!

This is what it means that a child is born to us. But there is still a for, which the angel says to the shepherds: "This is the sign for you: a child lying in a manger" (*Lk.* 2:12). This sign, the Child in the manger, is also for us, to guide us in life. In Bethlehem, which means "House of bread", God is in a manger, as if to remind us that in order to live we need him as bread to eat. We need to allow ourselves to be crossed by his *gratuitous*, *tireless*, *concrete* love. How many times, instead, hungry for fun, success and worldliness, we feed life with foods that do not feed and leave the void inside! The Lord, through the mouth of the prophet Isaiah, complained that, while the ox and the donkey know their manger, we, his people, do not know him, the source of our life (cf. *Is* 1,2-3). It is true: insatiable to have, we throw ourselves into many *mangers of vanity*, forgetting the manger in Bethlehem. That manger, poor in everything and rich in love, teaches that the nourishment of life is to let ourselves be loved by God and to love others. Jesus gives us the example: He, the Word of God, is an infant; he does not speak, but offers life. On the other hand, we talk a lot, but we are often *illiterate about goodness*.

We have been given a son. Anyone with a small child knows how much love and patience it takes. It is necessary to feed it, take care of it, clean it, take care of its fragility and its needs, which are often difficult to understand. A child makes you feel loved, but it also teaches you to love. God was born a child to move us to care for others. Her tender weeping makes us understand how useless so many of our whims are; and we have so many! His disarmed and disarming love reminds us that the time we have does not serve to cry over us, but to console the tears of those who suffer. God takes up residence near us, poor and needy, to tell us that by serving the poor we will love Him. Since tonight, as a poet wrote, "God's residence is next to mine. Furniture is love »(E. Dickinson, *Poems*, XVII).

We have been given a son. It is You, Jesus, the Son who makes me son. You love me as I am, not as I dream of being; I know it! Embracing You, Child of the manger, I embrace my life again. By welcoming you, Bread of life, I too want to give my life. You who save me, teach me to serve. You who do not leave me alone, help me to console your brothers, because you know from tonight they are all my brothers.
