

**Troparion** (tone 4): When the disciples of the Lord learned from the angel\* the glorious news of the resurrection\* and cast off the ancestral condemnation,\* they proudly told the apostles:\* "Death has been plundered!\* Christ our God is risen,\* granting to the world great mercy."

**Troparion** (tone 4): From your childhood you befriended wisdom,\* O God-inspired Cyril.\* Behold her as a pure virgin all radiant\* you took her as a brie for yourself,\* and as with beads of gold\* she adorned your mind and soul.\* O blessed Cyril,\* like your namesake of Alexandria\* we have found you wise in name and truth.

**Kontakion** (tone 2): O Master, Guide to Wisdom\*, Bestower of prudent counsel,\* Instructor of the foolish and Defender of the poor ones;\* make firm my heart and give it understanding.\* Give me a word, O Word of the Father:\* Behold, I shall not stop my lips from crying out to You:\* In Your mercy, have mercy on me who am fallen.

**Prokeimenon** (tone 8): Pray and give praise to the Lord our God.

verse: In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel.

Prokeimenon (tone 8): Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His venerable ones.

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans: (Rom. 13:11 - 14:4)

Brothers and Sisters: It is now the hour for you to wake from sleep, for our salvation is closer than when we first accepted the faith. The night is far spent; the day draws near. Let us cast off deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. Let us live honorably as in daylight, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual excess and lust, not in quarreling and jealousy. Rather, put on the Lord Jesus Christ and make no provision for the desires of the flesh.

Extend a kind welcome to those who are weak in faith. Do not enter into disputes with them. A man of sound faith knows he can eat anything, while one who is weak in faith eats only vegetables. The man who will eat anything must not ridicule him who abstains from certain foods; the man who abstains must not sit in judgment on him who eats. After all, God himself has made him welcome. Who are you to pass judgment on another's servant? His master alone can judge whether he stands or falls. And stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand.

## Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Hebrews (Hebrews 7:26-8:2)

Brothers and Sisters, for it was fitting that we should have such a high priest, holy, blameless, undefiled, separated from sinners, and exalted above the heavens. Unlike the other high priests, he has no need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for those of the people; this he did once for all when he offered himself. For the law appoints as high priests those who are subject to weakness, but the word of the oath, which came later than the law, appoints a Son who has been made perfect forever.

Now the main point in what we are saying is this: we have such a high priest, one who is seated at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens, a minister in the sanctuary and the true tent that the Lord, and not any mortal, has set up.

Alleluia (tone 6): It is good to give praise to the Lord, and to sing to Your name, O Most High. (Ps. 91, 2).

verse: To announce Your mercy in the morning and Your truth every night. (Ps. 91, 3).

verse: Blessed is the man who fears the Lord; he shall delight exceedingly in His commandments. (Ps. 91, 13).

**Gospel**: (Matthew 6:14 - 21)

The Lord said, for if you forgive others their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you; but if you do not forgive others, neither will your heavenly Father forgive your trespasses. "And whenever you fast, do not look dismal, like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces so as to show others that they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that your fasting may be seen not by others but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you. "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust consume and where thieves break in and steal; but store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust consumes and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

Gospel: (John 10:9-16)

The Lord said, I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly. "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away—and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.

Апостол: До Римлян Послання Святого Апостола Павла читання: (Рим. 13,11 - 14,4)

Браття і Сестри, вже пора вам прокинутись із сну: тепер бо ближче нас спасіння, ніж тоді, як ми увірували. Ніч проминула, день наблизився. Відкиньмо, отже, вчинки темряви й одягнімось у зброю світла. Як день, — поводьмося чесно: не в ненажерстві та пияцтві, не в перелюбі та розпусті, не у сварні та заздрощах; але вдягніться у Господа Ісуса Христа і не дбайте про тіло задля похотей.

Слабкого в вірі приймайте, не вступаючи з ним у суперечки. Один вірить, що можна все їсти, а слабкий (у вірі) їсть городину. # Апостол: До Євреїв Послання Святого Апостола Павла читання (Євр. 7,26-8:2)

Братт і Сестри, такого нам годилось мати первосвященика: святого, невинного, непорочного, відлученого від грішників і вищого небес, який не має потреби, як ті первосвященики, щодня приносити жертви перше за власні гріхи і потім за гріхи народу, бо він зробив це раз, принісши себе самого в жертву. Коли ж ви постите, не будьте сумні, як лицеміри: бо вони виснажують своє обличчя, щоб було видно людям, мовляв, вони постять. Істинно кажу вам: Вони вже мають свою нагороду.

Ти ж, коли постиш, намасти свою голову й умий своє обличчя, щоб не показати людям, що ти постиш, але Отцеві твоєму, що перебуває в тайні; і Отець твій, що бачить таємне, віддасть тобі. Не збирайте собі скарбів на землі, де міль і хробацтво нівечить, і де підкопують злодії і викрадають. Communal Right of Mutual Forgiveness

Explanation: Our Christian faith has been preserved through the ages in 2 ways: Scripture (written) and Tradition (verbal). Since parts of the second one are sometimes forgotten, the Church now is trying to bring them back into practice. One such practice of our Christian tradition is the Order of "Fraternal Reconciliation", a beautiful and meaningful practice of the ancient church community. Nowadays, it is most preserved in the monasteries and is being brought back by many of our parishes. After the Liturgy you are invited to participate in this Order. When the disciples of the Lord asked him to teach them how to pray (Luke 11:1- 13), He left us with what we refer to as the Lord's Pray - the "Our Father". In this prayer we pray as a community or family, we do not say "My Father who is in Heaven..." we pray: "Our Father..." We ask God to forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. Before beginning our Great Lent Journey, together as a parish community or family, it is important for us to express our desire to seek forgivness for anything that we may have done; that may have hurt or offended another in the past year or during our life time. It is also important to extend our forgiveness to others so that we can be free of these heavy burdens, and walk together as a family and as true sons and daughters of God! This Communal Right of Mutual Forgiveness is not the Mystery/Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) nor does it replace that Mystery/Sacrament, but rather is a tangible sign to each other of our willingness to forgive. It is a moment during which we can experience being forgiven as well as extending forgiveness. Hence there is no need to name our offenses, but rather with total sincerity in our hearts we us say to each other: "Forgive me my brother/sister" and answer with sincerity and love, "May God have mercy on you and know that I forgive you."

"O Master, Guide to Wisdom, Bestower of prudent counsel, Instructor of the foolish and Defender of the poor ones; make firm my heart and give it understanding. Give me a word, O Word of the Father:

Behold, I shall not stop my lips from crying out to You: In Your mercy,

**have mercy on me who am fallen.**" – Kontakion of the Sunday of Forgiveness prayerfully reminds all of us today

*Priest:* Humbly bowing our heads and knees, let us pray to the Lord.

Faithful: Lord, have mercy.

**Priest:** O Lord Jesus Christ our God, the hope of all the lands of this earth and of those who are far at sea and high in the air, you gave us these holy days of Lent through your laws and prophets, thus giving us an example of penance and the mortification of our passions. You yourself after the fulfillment of time came in body to this world and having fasted forty days and forty nights you instituted and sanctified the Lent. Therefore, being generous and merciful, bless us all, that we may in perfect penitence, in true humility, in prayers and profound bows, in hunger and thirst, and frequent kneeling, in the contriteness of our heart, we may begin these holy days of Lent, and without sin and with a clean conscience to complete them, by guarding the true faith and to become victors over sin. Bestow unto us an Angel of peace that he would guard our lives, that they would not be endangered or destroyed by the visits of the enemy or evil circumstances.

Teach us to always do good, strengthen us by your power for this Lenten struggle against our passions, to cleanse our souls and bodies, that we may be worthy and without judgment to receive communion of your most Holy Body and most precious and lifegiving Blood. For you are the God of graces and mercies and lover of mankind, and desire that all would be saved. We give glory to you and to your eternal Father, and to your Most Holy, good and Life-Spirit, now and forever and ever.

Faithful: Amen.

<u>Priest:</u> Bless me, my Sisters and Brothers, and forgive me, a sinner, whatever offenses I may have committed this day and all the days of my life by word, deed and thought as well as by all my senses. (bows to all the faithful)

<u>Faithful:</u> May God forgive you, Reverend Father. Bless us also and forgive our offences voluntary and involuntary. *(also bow)* 

Priest: May the Lord God by His grace forgive you all your sins and have mercy on you.

Let us pray for our Most Holy Universal Pontiff Francis Pope of Rome, for His Beatitude Patriarch Sviatoslav, for our Most Reverend Metropolitan Lawrence, for our God-loving Bishop David, and the God-loving Bishop-Emeritus Severian, all our priestly, diaconal and religious orders, our nation, government and all people in service of our country.

Faithful: May God save and have mercy.

<u>Priest:</u> For the noble benefactors, founders and all parishioners of this holy church, for those who serve and who have served in it.

Faithful: May God save and have mercy.

Priest: For those who are absent and for those who are travelling.

Priest: For our benefactors and those who are kind to us.

Faithful: May God protect and have mercy. Faithful: May God reward and have mercy.

<u>Priest:</u> For those who hate us and for those who love us. <u>Faithful:</u> **May God forgive and have mercy.**
