If you would like to come to Confession, meet with the parish priest individually at the church or parish office, receive spiritual care and support via telephone or internet, want him to visit you, your relative or friend at their home, hospital or care homes, please, call or email the pastor in advance to arrange time and a day.

Liturgical Propers in English language:

Troparion (tone 8): You came down from on high, O Merciful One and accepted three days of burial to free us from our sufferings. O Lord, our life and our resurrection, glory be to You.

Troparion (tone 4): Clothed as in purple and fine linen with the blood of Your martyrs throughout the world, Your Church cries out to You through them, O Christ God: send down Your loving-kindness on Your people; grant peace to Your community, and to our souls great mercy.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion (tone 8): O Lord, Maker of nature, the world offers You the godly martyrs as the first fruits of nature. By their supplications, through the Mother of God, preserve Your Church and Your people in profound peace, O most merciful One.

Prokimenon (tone 8): Pray and give praise to the Lord our God (*Ps* 75:12). *Verse*: In Judea God is known; His name is great in Israel (*Ps* 75:2).

Prokimenon (tone 4): God is wonderful in His saints, the God of Israel (Ps 67:36).

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of St. Paul to the Hebrews: (Heb. 11:33-12:2a)

Brothers and Sisters, by faith the saints conquered kingdoms, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, became strong in battle, and turned back foreign invaders. Woman received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned, sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet

despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which includes us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect.

Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and preserve in running the race which lies ahead; let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

Alleluia (tone 4): The just cried out and the Lord heard them, and delivered them from all their afflictions (Ps. 33:18). The afflictions of the just are many, but out of them all will the Lord deliver them (Ps. 33:20). The heavens shall confess Your wonders, O Lord, and Your truth in the church of the saints (Ps. 88:6).

Gospel: (Matthew 10:32-33; 37-38; 19:27-30)

The Lord said to his disciples, "whoever acknowledges me before people I will acknowledge before my Father in heaven. Whoever disowns me before people I will disown before my Father in heaven. Whoever loves father or mother, son or daughter, more that me is not worthy of me. Whoever will not take up his or her cross and come after me is not worthy of me."

"Then it was Peter's turn to say to him: "Here we have put everything aside to follow you. What we can expect from it?" Jesus said to them: "I give you my solemn word, in the new age when the Son of Man takes his seat upon a throne befitting his glory, you who have followed me shall likewise take your places on twelve thrones to judge the twelve tribes of Israel. Moreover, everyone who has given up home, brothers or sisters, father or mother, wife or children or property for my sake will receive many times as much and inherit everlasting life. Many who are first shall come last, and the last shall come first.

Communion Verses: Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the highest (*Ps. 148:1*). Rejoice in the Lord, O you just; praise befits the righteous (*Ps. 32:1*). Alleluia! (*x3*)

At the conclusion of every Divine Liturgy, we say an additional prayer for peace in Ukraine, and healing of the World let us pray: Our Father ... Hail Mary ... Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Браття і Сестри, всі святі вірою підбили царства, чинили справедливість, обітниць осягнули, загородили пащі левам, силу вогню гасили, вістря меча уникали, ставали сильні, бувши недолугі, на війні проявили мужність, наскоки чужинців відбивали. Жінки діставали назад своїх померлих, які воскресали. Інші загинули в муках, відкинувши визволення, щоб осягнути ліпше воскресіння. Інші наруг і бичів зазнали та ще й кайданів і в'язниці; їх каменовано, розрізувано пилою, брано на допити; вони вмирали, мечем забиті; тинялися в овечих та козячих шкурах, збідовані, гноблені, кривджені; вони, яких світ був невартий, блукали пустинями, горами, печерами та земними вертепами. І всі вони, дарма що мали добре засвідчення вірою, не одержали обіцяного, бо Бог зберіг нам щось краще, щоб вони не без нас осягли досконалість. Тому і ми, маючи навколо себе таку велику хмару свідків, відкиньмо всякий тягар і гріх, що так легко обмотує, і біжімо витривало до змагання, що призначене нам, вдивляючися пильно в Ісуса, засновника й завершителя віри, який, замість радости, що перед ним була, витерпів хрест, на сором не звертаючи уваги, і який возсів праворуч Божого престолу.

SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS: Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! We also pray for the people of Ukraine, that with the help of the Holy Spirit, they may obtain social peace, political harmony and economic stability: Lord, hear us and have mercy.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast - no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry:

Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment.

Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time, Holy Unction (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time), Funerals and Memorials: by appointment.



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Parishioners and Friends

The Provincial Health Officer has announced a new variance on indoor religious gatherings as of May 26, 2021.

- The maximum number of people who may attend a service is 50 people
- All who wish to attend Sunday service must pre-register for the purposes of controlling attendance and contact tracing. For registration, please contact directly Fr. Pavlo at dormitionkelowna@gmail.com phone the church at (250) 860-7295 or call/text your pastor's cell phone at (250) 299-7249 (Your Name / email or tel # / how many people)
- Before attending a church, a person must carry out a health check SIGN-IN AND QUESTIONNAIRE (you can do it at the entrance to the church). A person who has not passed a health check must not attend a church.
 - o Have I traveled outside of Canada, within the last 14 days? YES or NO
 - o Have I been close to someone infected with COVID-19? YES or NO
 - ols anyone in my household quarantined or in isolation? YES or NO
 - o Do I have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat? YES or NO
- Hand sanitizers to be available.
- Masks need to be worn during services. A person is not required to wear a mask if,
 - ochildren under the age of 12 years
 - opeople who cannot put on or remove a mask on their own
 - opeople with health conditions or with physical, cognitive or mental impairments
 - opeople who need to temporarily remove their masks to identifying the person, to communicate with a person with a disability or to receive the Holy Communion.
 - opriests, cantors, readers (when speaking, singing or chanting). They must maintain 3 meters of spacing or use a physical barrier.
- Distance of two meters must be maintained between parishioners, unless they live in the same residence.
- No choir. Only designated cantors.
- If feasible, during a service, doors and windows should be kept open to increase ventilation, and mechanical ventilation should be maximized to the extent possible.
- No social gathering before and/or after the service. Parishioners must disperse immediately after a service.

Let us all be responsible, understand and cooperate by ensuring that we and all the other people stay safe and healthy!

Please be assured of my priestly prayers for you and all your dear ones daily. I also would like to invite and encourage every one of you to pray for each other, ill people and their dear ones, medical workers, and also my family and all people who are under my pastoral-spiritual care!
