Liturgical Propers in English language:

First Antiphon:

Verse 1: Shout to the Lord, all the earth, sing now to His name, give glory to His praise (Ps 65:2). *Refrain:* Through the prayers of the Mother of God, O Saviour, save us.

Verse 2: The voice of Your thunder was in the whirlwind; Your lightning lit up the world (Ps 76:19). *Refrain:* Through the prayers of the Mother of God, O Saviour, save us.

Verse 3: You have clothed Yourself in praise and splendour; You robe Yourself in light as with a cloak (Ps 103:1-2). *Refrain: Refrain: Through the prayers of the Mother of God, O Saviour, save us.*

Third Antiphon:

We sing the usual Third Antiphon, but with the festal refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Troparion (Tone 2): When You went down to death, O Life Immortal, You struck Hades dead with the blazing light of Your Divinity. When You raised the dead from the nether world, all the powers of heaven cried out: "O Giver of Life, Christ our God, glory be to You!"

Troparion (Tone 7): You were transfigured on the mount, O Christ God, showing Your glory to Your disciples as much as they could bear. Make Your eternal light shine also on us who are sinners, through the prayers of the Mother of God, O Giver of Light, glory to You!

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.



Kontakion (Tone 2): You arose from the tomb, O Almighty Saviour, and Hades, seeing this wonder, was stricken with fear; and the dead arose. Creation saw and rejoices with You, and Adam exults. And the World, my Saviour, sings Your praises for ever.

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion (Tone 7): You were transfigured on the mount, O Christ God, and Your disciples saw Your glory as much as they could; that when they saw You crucified, they might know that You suffered willingly, and might proclaim to the world that You are truly the brightness of the Father.

Prokimenon (tone 2): The Lord Is my strength and my song of praise, and He has become my salvation. (Ps. 118:14).

Verse: The Lord has indeed chastised me, but He has not delivered me to death. (Ps. 118:18).

Prokimenon (tone 4): How great are Your works, O Lord, You have made all things in wisdom. (Ps. 104:24).

Epistle: A reading from the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians: (1 Cor. 9:2-12)

Brethren, although I may not be an apostle for others, I certainly am one for you. You are the very seal of my apostolate in the Lord.

My defense against those who criticize me is this: Do we not have the right to eat and drink? Do we not have the right to marry a believing woman like the rest of the apostles and the brothers of the Lord and Cephas (Se-fas)? Is it only myself and Barnabas who are forced to work for a living? What soldier in the field pays for his rations? Who plants a vineyard and does not eat of its yield? What shepherd does not nourish himself with the milk of his flock? You may think the reasons I am giving are merely human ones, but does not the law itself speak of these things? It is written in the law of Moses, 'You shall not muzzle an ox while it



treads out grain.' Is God concerned here for oxen, or does He not rather say this for our sakes? You can be sure it was written for us, for the plowman should plow in hope and the harvester expect a share in the grain. If we have sown for you in the spirit, is it too much to expect a material harvest from you? If others have this right over you, is not our right even greater? But we have not used it right. On the contrary, we put up with all sorts of hardships so as not to place any obstacle in the way of the gospel of Christ.

Alleluia (Tone 2): The Lord will hear you in the day of tribulation; the name of the God of Jacob will shield you. (Ps. 19:2)

Lord, grant victory to the king and hear us in the day that we shall call upon You. (Ps. 19:10)

Gospel: (Mt 18:23-35)

The Lord told this parable: The reign of God may be said to be like a king who decided to settle accounts with his officials. When he began his auditing, one was brought in who owed him a huge amount. As he had no way of paying it, his master ordered him to be sold, among with his wife, his children and all his property, in payment of the debt. At that the official prostrated himself in homage and said, "My lord, be patient with me and I will pay you back in full." Moved with pity, the master le the official go and wrote off the debt. But when that same official went out he met a fellow servant who owed him a mere fraction of what he himself owed: He seized him and throttled him. "Pay back what you owe," he demanded. His fellow servant dropped to his knees and began to plead with him, "Just give me time and I will pay you back in full." But he would here none of it. Instead, he had him put in jail until he paid back what he owed. When his fellow servants saw what had happened they were badly shaken, and went to their master to report the whole incident. His master sent for him and said, "You worthless wretch! I canceled your entire debt when you pleaded with me. Should you not have dealt mercifully with your fellow servant, as I dealt with you?" Then in anger the master handed him over to the torturers until he paid back all that he owed. My heavenly Father will treat you in exactly the same way unless each of you forgives your brother and sister from your heart."

Instead of "It is truly...": O my soul, magnify the Lord transfigured on the mountain.

Irmos (Tone 4): Your giving birth was revealed as incorrupt; for it was God who came forth from your womb; He appeared on earth in the flesh, and made His dwelling among us. Thus, O Mother of God, all of us magnify you.

Communion Verses: Praise the Lord from the heavens; praise Him in the highest (*Ps 148:1*). We will walk in the light of Your face, O Lord, and rejoice in Your name forever. (*Ps. 88, 16-18*). Alleluia! (x3)

At the conclusion of every Divine Liturgy, we say an additional prayer for peace in Ukraine, and healing of the World let us pray: Our Father ... Hail Mary ... Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Кондак (глас 7): На горі переобразився Ти і, скільки змогли, ученики твої славу Твою, Христе Боже, виділи, щоб, коли побачать, як тебе розпинають, страждання зрозуміли добровільне, а світові проповідять, що ти єси воістину Отче сяяння.

Прокімен (глас 2): Господь – моя сила і моя пісня, і Він став моїм спасінням (Пс. 117,14).

Стих: Тяжко покарав мене Господь, та не поередав мене смерті (Пс. 117,18).

Прокімен (глас 4): Які величні діла Твої, Господи!* Все премудро сотворив Ти (Пс. 103, 24).

<u>Апостол</u>: До Коринтян послання Святого Апостола Павла читання: (1 Кор. 9, 2-12):

Браття і Сестри, коли іншим я не апостол, то бодай вам, бо ви, у Господі, є достовірним доказом мого апостольства. Ось моя оборона перед тими, що мене судять. Хіба ми не маємо права їсти й пити? Хіба ми не маємо права водити (з собою) сестру-жінку, як інші апостоли, брати Господні, і Кифа? Чи може один я і Варнава не маємо права не працювати? Хто колись власним коштом ходив у похід? Хто садить виноградник, і не їсть із нього плоду? Хто пасе стадо, і не живиться молоком від стада? Хіба я говорю тільки як людина? Хіба й закон не каже цього? Таж у законі Мойсея написано: «Не зав'язуй рота волові, як молотить.» Чи Бог турбується про волів? Чи, може, ради нас говорить? Бо ж ради нас написано, що, хто оре, мусить орати в надії, і хто молотить, молотить теж у надії, що матиме щось із того. Коли ж ми сіяли у вас духовне, то чи велика річ, коли пожнем ваше тілесне? І коли інші мають це право над вами, чому радше не ми? Однак, ми не користуємося цим правом, а ввесь час терпимо, щоб не робити ніякої перешкоди Євангелії Христовій.

Сказав Господь притчу оцю: "Царство Небесне схоже на царя, що хотів звести рахунки з слугами своїми. Коли він розпочав зводити рахунки, приведено йому одного, що винен був десять тисяч талантів. А що не мав той чим віддати, то пан і звелів його продати, а й жінку, дітей і все, що він мав, і віддати. Тоді слуга, впавши йому в ноги, поклонився лицем до землі й каже: Потерпи мені, пане, все тобі поверну. І змилосердився пан над тим слугою, відпустив його й подарував йому борг той. Вийшовши той слуга, здибав одного з своїх співслуг, який винен був йому сто динаріїв, схопив його й заходився душити його, кажучи: Віддай, що винен. Тож співслуга його впав йому в ноги й почав його просити: Потерпи мені, я тобі зверну. Та той не хотів, а пішов і кинув його в темницю, аж поки не поверне борг. Якже побачили товариші його, що сталося, засмутились вельми, пішли до свого пана й розповіли йому про все сподіяне. Тоді його пан покликав його і сказав до нього: Слуго лукавий! Я простив тобі ввесь борг той, бо ти мене благав. Чи не слід було й тобі змилосердитись над твоїм товаришем, як я був змилосердився над тобою? І розгнівавшись його пан, передав його катам, аж поки йому не поверне всього боргу. Отак і мій Отець Небесний буде чинити вам, якщо кожний з вас не прощатиме братові своєму з серця свого."

SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS: Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! We also pray for the people of Ukraine, that with the help of the Holy Spirit, they may obtain social peace, political harmony and economic stability: Lord, hear us and have mercy.



Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast - no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry: Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment. Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time. Holy Unction (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time). Funerals and Memorials: by appointment.

Pope Francis teaches about Slavery.....

01.06.18 A.D. Holy Mass Santa Marta 1 Peter 4: 7-13

Persecution is rather like the 'air' that Christians breathe even today. Because even today there are many martyrs, many people who are persecuted for their love of Christ. There are many countries where Christians have no rights. If you wear a cross, you go to jail. And there are people in jail. There are people condemned to death today simply because they are Christians. The number of people killed is higher than the number of early martyrs. It's higher! But this doesn't make news. Television newscasts and newspapers don't cover these things. Meanwhile Christians are being persecuted.

The Devil is behind every persecution, both of Christians and all human beings. The Devil tries to destroy the presence of Christ in Christians, and the image of God in men and women. He tried doing this from the very beginning, as we read in the Book of Genesis: he tried to destroy that harmony that the Lord created between man and woman,

the harmony that comes from being made in the image and likeness of God. And he succeeded. He managed to do it by using deception, seduction...the weapons he uses. He always does this. But there is a powerful ruthlessness against men and women today: otherwise how to explain this growing wave of destruction towards men and women, and all that is human".

Hunger is an injustice that destroys men and women because they have nothing to eat, even if there is a lot food available in the world. Human exploitation; different forms of slavery; recently I saw a film shot inside a prison where migrants are locked up and tortured to turn them into slaves. This is still happening 70 years after the Declaration of Human Rights. Cultural colonization. This is exactly what the Devil wants, to destroy human dignity – and that is why the Devil is behind all forms of persecution.

Wars can be considered a kind of instrument to destroy people, made in the image of God. But so are the people who make war, who plan war in order to exercise power over others. There are people who promote the arms industry to destroy humanity, to destroy the image of man and woman, physically morally, and culturally... Even if they are not Christians, the Devil persecutes them because they are the image of God. We must not be ingenuous. In the world today, all humans, and not only Christians are being persecuted, because the Father of all persecutions cannot bare that they are the image and likeness of God. So he attacks and destroys that image. It isn't easy to understand this. We have to pray a lot if we want to understand it. ...

08.04.20 A.D. Holy Mass, Casa Santa Marta (Domus Sanctae Marthae) Wednesday of Holy Week Matthew 26: 14-25

Let us pray today for those people who in this time of pandemic are taking advantage of those in need: they are profiting from the necessity of others and sell them: the mafia, those who lend and many others. May the Lord touch their hearts and convert them.

Holy Wednesday is also called "Spy Wednesday" or "Betrayal Wednesday", the day on which the Church emphasizes the betrayal of Judas. Judas sells the Master.

When we think about selling people, what comes to mind is the slave trade made that took place between Africa and America – an old thing – then the trade, for example, of Yazidi girls sold to Daesh: but it is a distant thing, it is a thing ... Even today people are sold. Every day. There are Judas's who sell their brothers and sisters, exploiting them in their work, not paying the just wage, not recognizing their duties ... In fact, many time they sell those who are most dear to us. I think that to be more comfortable one is able to turn away parents and not see them anymore, put them safe in a nursing home and not go to see them ... Sell them. There is a very common saying that, speaking of people like this, says that "he is capable of selling his mother": and they sell them. Now they are quiet, they are turned away: "Take care of them you ...".

Today human trafficking is as it was in earlier times: it is done. Why is that? Because as Jesus said. They made money a lord. Jesus said, "You cannot serve God and money," two lords. There is only one thing that Jesus puts to us and each one of us must choose: either serve God, and you will be free in adoration and service, or you serve money, and you will be a slave to money. This is the option and so many people want to serve God and money. And that can't be done. In the end, they pretend to serve God to serve money. They are the hidden exploiters who are socially impeccable, but under the table they trade, even with people: it doesn't matter. Human exploitation is selling ones neighbour.

Judas went away, but he has left disciples, who are not his disciples but the devils. What Judas's life was like, we don't know. A normal boy, perhaps, with anxieties, because the Lord called him to be a disciple. He never succeeded in being one: he didn't have a disciple's way of talking and a disciple's heart, as we read in the first Reading. He was weak in his discipleship, but Jesus loved him. You can say he was a worthy person. Then the Gospel makes us understand that he liked money: at Lazarus's house, when Mary anoints the feet of Jesus with that expensive perfume, he makes the reflection and John points out: "But he does not say it because he loved the poor: because he was a thief". Love of money had led him outside of the rules, to steal, and from steeling to betraying there is only a little step. Those who love money too much betray to get more, always: it is a rule, it is a fact. The boy Judas, perhaps good, with good intentions, ends up a traitor to the point of going to the market to sell him: "He went to the chief priests and said, "What are you willing to give me for me to hand him over to you, directly?" In my opinion, this man was out of his mind.

One thing that catches my attention is that Jesus never says "traitor"; he says he will be betrayed, but does not call him "traitor." He never says, "Go away, traitor." Never! In fact, he says to him, "Friend," and kisses him. The mystery of Judas ... What is the mystery of Judas? I don't know... Don Primo Mazzolari explained it better than I did ... Yes, I console myself to contemplate that capital of Vezelay: how did Judas end? I don't know. Jesus threatens strongly here; a strong threat: "Woe to that man from whom the Son of Man is betrayed: better for that man if he had never been born!" But does that mean Judas is in hell? I don't know. I look at the capital. And I hear the word of Jesus: "Friend."

But this makes us think of another thing, which is more real today: the devil entered Judas, it was the devil who led him to this point. And how did the story end? The devil is a bad payer: he is not a reliable payer. He promises you everything, makes you see everything and in the end leaves you alone in your desperation to hang yourself.

The heart of Judas, restless, tormented by greed and tormented by love of Jesus, a love that has failed, tormented with this fog that he was in, he returns to the priests asking for forgiveness, asking for salvation. "What is that to us? Look to it yourself ...": the devil speaks like this and leaves us in despair.

Let us think of so many institutionalized Judas in this world, who exploit people. And let us also think of the little Judas that each of us has within ourselves at the hour of choosing: between loyalty or self-interest. Each of us has the capacity to betray, to sell, to choose for our own interest. Each of us has the possibility of being attracted to the love of money or goods or future well-being. "Judas, where are you?" But each of us has to ask the question: "You, Judas, the little Judas I have inside: where are you?"
