For the Sundays of Great Fast-Lent the Typicon prescribes the Divine Liturgy of Saint Basil the Great

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Hebrews (Hebrews 11:24-26; 32-40; 12:1-2a)

Brethren, by faith Moses, when he had grown up, refused to be known as the son of Pharaoh's daughter; he wished to be ill-treated along with God's people rather than enjoy the fleeting rewards of sin. Moses considered the reproach borne by God's Anointed greater riches than the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking to the reward.

What more shall I recount? I have no time to tell of Gideon, Barak, Samson, Jephthah, of David and Samuel and the prophets, who by faith conquered kingdoms, did what was just, obtained the promises; they broke the jaws of lions, put out raging fires, escaped the devouring sword; though weak they were made powerful, received back their dead through resurrection. Others were tortured and would not receive deliverance, in order to obtain a better resurrection. Still others endured mockery, scourging, even chains and imprisonment. They were stoned; sawed in two, put to death at sword's point; they went about garbed in the skins of sheep or goats, needy, afflicted, tormented. The world was not worthy of them. They wandered about in deserts and on mountains, they dwelt in caves and in holes of the earth. Yet despite the fact that all of these were approved because of their faith, they did not obtain what had been promised. God had made a better plan, a plan which includes us. Without us, they were not to be made perfect.

Therefore, since we for our part are surrounded by this cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every encumbrance of sin which clings to us and preserve in running the race which lies ahead; let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, who inspires and perfects our faith.

Gospel: (John 1:43-51)

At that time, Jesus wanted to set out for Galilee, but first he came upon Philip. "Follow me," Jesus said to him. Now Philip was from Bethsaida, the same town as Andrew and Peter. Philip sought out Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses spoke of in the law – the prophets too – Jesus, son of Joseph, from Nazareth." Nathanael's response to that was, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" and Philip replied, "Come, see for yourself."

When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he remarked: "This man is a true Israelite. There is no guile in him." "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked him. "Before Philip called you," Jesus answered, "I saw you under the fig tree." "Rabbi," said Nathanael, "you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel." Jesus responded: "Do you believe just because I told you I saw you under the fig tree? You will see much greater things than that."

He went on to tell them, "I solemnly assure you, you shall see the sky opened and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man."

At the conclusion of every Divine Liturgy, we say an additional prayer for peace in Ukraine until the end of the war and for peace in the World: Our Father ... Hail Mary ... Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Апостол: До Євреїв Послання Святого Апостола Павла читання: (Євр. 11:24-26, 32-40, 12:1-2a)

Браття і сестри, вірою Мойсей, коли був виріс, відрікся зватися сином дочки фараона; волів радше страждати разом з людом Божим, ніж дознавати дочасної гріховної втіхи, бо, дивлячись на нагороду, вважав за більше багатство наругу вибраного народу від скарбів Єгипту. І що ще скажу? Часу не вистане мені, коли заходжуся розповідати про Гедеона, про Варака, про Самсона, про Єфту, про Давида й Самуїла та пророків, що вірою підбили царства, чинили справедливість, обітниць осягнули, загородили пащі левам, силу вогню гасили, вістря меча уникали, ставали сильні, бувши недолугі, на війні проявили мужність, наскоки чужинців відбивали. Жінки діставали назад своїх померлих, які воскресали. Інші загинули в муках, відкинувши визволення, щоб осягнути ліпше воскресіння. Інші наруг і бичів зазнали та ще й кайданів і в'язниці; їх каменовано, розрізувано пилою, брано на допити; вони вмирали, мечем забиті; тинялися в овечих та козячих шкурах, збідовані, гноблені, кривджені; вони, яких світ був невартий, блукали пустинями, горами, печерами та земними вертепами. І всі вони, дарма що мали добре засвідчення вірою, не одержали обіцяного, бо Бог зберіг нам щось краще, щоб вони не без нас осягли досконалість. Тому і ми, маючи навколо себе таку велику хмару свідків, відкиньмо всякий тягар і гріх, що так легко обмотує, і біжімо витривало до змагання, що призначене нам, вдивляючися пильно в Ісуса, засновника й завершителя віри, який, замість радости, що перед ним була, витерпів хрест, на сором не звертаючи уваги, і який возсів праворуч Божого престолу.

Євангеліє: (Івана 1:43-51)

У той час вирішив Ісус піти в Галилею; і знайшовши Филипа, мовив до нього: «Іди за мною.» А був Филип з Витсаїди, з міста Андрієвого та Петрового. Зустрів Филип Натанаїла і сказав до нього: «Ми знайшли того, про кого Мойсей у законі писав і пророки, — Ісуса Йосифового сина, з Назарету.» Натанаїл же йому на те: «А що доброго може бути з Назарету?» Мовив до нього Филип: «Прийди та подивися.» Побачивши Ісус, що Натанаїл надходив до нього, сказав про нього: «Ось справжній ізраїльтянин, що нема в ньому лукавства.» Натанаїл же йому: «Звідкіль знаєш мене?» Сказав Ісус, промовивши до нього: «Перше, ніж Филип закликав тебе, бачив я тебе,

як був єси під смоковницею.» Відповів же йому Натанаїл: «Учителю, ти – Син Божий, ти – цар Ізраїлів.» Ісус відказав, мовивши

Please, also in your kindness keep praying those daily for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. Remember to ask for special blessings to all Christian families and yourselves! REMINDER for families of individuals, who are admitted to hospital - If you or a family member is admitted

to hospital and you wish to have a priest visit, please be sure to have someone call our parish rectory office to make this request. Your pastor may have no other way of knowing that you are in hospital, as privacy legislation.

SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS: Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! We also pray for the people of Ukraine, that with the help of the Holy Spirit, they may obtain social peace, political harmony and economic stability: Lord, hear us and have mercy.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

<u>Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry:</u> Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment. Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time. Holy Unction (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time). Funerals and Memorials: by appointment.

YOUR PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY AND RESPECT OF OTHERS: After each Divine Liturgy and every church service, please, keep silence in the House of the Lord as some of the faithful are still praying at the church as well. In consideration of other Christians at the church house of prayer to the Lord Our Almighty and Omnipresent God, please do not leave any itemsl in the pews. Always love, pray and be respectful toward other people! Let each of us do our part to be true stewards of our parish church by helping to keep the church building safe and cleant. Thank you very much for your understanding, help and care! Please always remember that we come together to the church to glorify Lord Our God and spiritually grow as a Christian community and church as house of prayer helps us during our temporal life journey.

BE A STEWARD: Have you ever wondered what more can you do to help our parish-church? Here are some suggestions: Steward of property security; Steward of grounds cleaning; Steward of cleaning church; Steward of church linen; Steward of outreach; Steward of caring; Steward of prayer; Steward of service. Quite often, our homebound or senior members, once active in their younger years, want to find purpose in their senior years. It's not only about doing but about "BEING" present to others! Financial Secretary is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is monitoring all funds received by the parish and ensure that all such funds are doposited in the parish bank account; keeping accurate records of all income and expenditures; keeps in in order and preserves documents, records and books of parish finances. He/She is a signing officer, together with the pastor, for property approved financial transactions. He/She presents at the AGM the statements of income and expences, as well as the balance sheet, for the calendar year as prepared by him or her or, where necessary, by an independent accounting firm.

Treasurer is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is greatly helping the financial secretary to monitor all funds received by the parish and ensure that all such funds are doposited in the parish bank account; keeping accurate records of all income and expenditures (paying all invoices-bills and reimbursements); keeps in in order and preserves documents, records and books of parish finances. He/She is a signing officer, together with the pastor, for property approved financial transactions.

It is also very important, vibrant and vital for our Christian community-family to have active and carrying representatives (a leader and helpers) at different Parish Committees such as: Liturgical, Spiritual Care, Educational, Children Ministry, Youth Ministry, Senior Ministry, Decoration / Beautification, Maintenance, Kitchen, Social / Public Relations.

Pope Francis on Ash Wednesday: Lent is a time for conversion and interior renewal


Pope Francis said on Ash Wednesday that the Lenten season provides an opportunity for conversion and interior renewal.

"Let us prepare ourselves with confidence to follow the Lenten journey that begins today as an opportunity for conversion and interior renewal in listening to the Word of God, in prayer, in the daily exercise of charity towards one's neighbor," the pope said on March 2.

The pope was speaking at the end of his live streamed general audience, dedicated to the importance of spending time with the elderly.

Pope Francis also reminded pilgrims gathered in the Vatican's Paul VI Hall that March 2 is a global day of prayer and fasting for peace in Ukraine.

"Our prayer and fasting will be a plea for peace in Ukraine, remembering that world peace always begins with our personal conversion, following Christ," the pope said in his message to French-speaking pilgrims.

The general audience is the only public event on Pope Francis' schedule for Ash Wednesday.

Last week, the pope canceled his participation in the customary Ash Wednesday procession on Rome's Aventine Hill and Mass at the Basilica of Santa Sabina due to doctor-ordered rest for acute knee pain.

At the general audience, the pope walked out on the stage on his own with a smile and a wave, as he does every week. At the end of the audience, he was assisted by one other person to walk down the stairs slowly to greet pilgrims gathered in the Paul VI Hall.

In his reflection, Pope Francis was critical of the "obsession with speed" in many modern societies.

In a culture obsessed with efficiency in which "slower pace means losses and speed is money," the pope recommended "wasting time" with children and the elderly, noting that this is not a waste but fundamental for society and strengthens the human family.

"I ask: Do you know how to waste time, or are you always in a hurry? 'No, I'm in a rush, I can't...' Do you know how to waste time with grandparents, with the elderly? Do you know how to spend time playing with your children," Pope Francis asked. "This is the touchstone. Think about it. And this restores to each person the love for our vulnerable life, blocking the road of the obsession with speed, which simply consumes it."

In his 2022 Lenten message, Pope Francis has also recommended that the 40 days of Lent be a time to confront addiction to digital media and focus instead on encountering those in need face to face.

"The arrogance of the time of the clock must be converted into the beauty of the rhythms of life. This is the reform we must make in our hearts, in the family, and in society," the pope said at the audience.

Pope Francis noted that many modern cities tend to be "hostile to the elderly, and not by chance, also to children."

He said: "This society has this spirit of rejection. It rejects so many unwanted children and it rejects the elderly. It casts them aside — they are no use — to rest homes, hospitals..."

"One completely loses sight of the bigger picture... The excess of speed pulverizes life: it does not make it more intense," he added.

Pope Francis underlined that while old age imposes a slower pace, it is not a "time of inertia."

"The meaning of life is not only in adulthood, say, from 25 to 60 years — no. The meaning of life is all of it, from birth to death, and you should be able to interact with everyone, and also to have emotional relationships with everyone, so that your maturity will be richer and stronger," he said.

The pope stressed the importance of more interactions between people of different generations.

"The alliance of the generations is indispensable. A society in which the elderly do not speak with the young, the young do not speak with the elderly, is a sterile society, without a future, a society that does not look to the horizon but rather looks at itself. And it becomes lonely," he said.

"May God help us to find the right music for this harmonization of the various ages: the little ones, the elderly, adults, everyone together: a beautiful symphony of dialogue."

Про це сказав Отець і Глава Української Греко-Католицької Церкви Блаженніший Святослав у своєму щоденному відеозверненні з Києва.

«Сьогодні переживаємо сьомий день війни. Цього дня, 2 березня 2022 року, на заклик Святішого Отця Папи Франциска весь світ єднається в молитві і пості за мир в Україні», – сказав він

За словами Глави УГКЦ, сьогодні особливий день, бо відчуваємо, що в нашій біді ми не самотні, хоча війна продовжується. Цієї ночі бомбардували наш Житомир. Продовжують обстрілювати наші міста і села. Ми особливо переживаємо за Харків, Суми, Чернігів, Херсон та інші українські міста, які попали в облогу, де вже сьогодні є великий брак харчів і ліків, важко рятувати місцеве населення.

Але ми сьогодні єднаємося в молитві. «Що означає єднатися в молитві? Останніми днями ми говорили, що лише коли ми будемо єдиними, об'єднаними — будемо сильними і зможемо вистояти в цій війні, — запевнив він. — «У єдності сила народу. Боже, нам єдність подай», — каже народний гімн. Проте єдність у молитві — це щось глибше. Єднатися в молитві означає обмінюватися життям. Означає свою життєву силу ділити з ближнім, віддавати її ближньому. А відтак ставати сильнішим через ту життєву силу, яку ми отримуємо з тим, хто зі мною єднається в молитві».

Блаженніший Святослав відзначив, що цими днями було скеровано дуже багато листів до нас з усього світу із запевненням: ми з вами.

«Ми сьогодні так потребуємо того взаємного підсилення. Бо ця сила, це єднання є ніщо інше як сила і єднання Святого Духа. Єднаючись у молитві, єднаючись нашим внутрішнім духовним життям зі світом, ми усвідомлюємо себе синами і доньками єдиної Церкви Христової, тіла Христового, Главою якого є Він сам. Цього дня ми молимося і постимо разом», — сказав він.

Блаженніший Святослав закликає також до посту, бо «цим ми будемо солідаризуватися з тими, хто сьогодні не має достатньо їжі». «Постити дуже важливо. Це означає позбуватися всього того, що нас роз'єднує, того, що нам заважає, а одночасно поділитися своїм життям з іншими. Тому цей піст сьогодні є таким важливим, щоб вигнати того, хто розділяє, – диявола, духа війни, духа смерті», – зазначив Предстоятель УГКЦ.

«Боже, прийми наш піст і нашу молитву. Боже, з'єднай нас усіх. Нехай життя переможе смерть. І нехай спільна молитва всього світу принесе мир Україні», – попросив він.


