#### Liturgical propers in English language:

*Troparion* (Tone 1): Though the stone was sealed by the Judeans,\* and soldiers guarded Your most pure body,\* You arose, O Saviour, on the third day,\* and gave life to the world.\* And so the heavenly powers cried out to You, O Giver of Life:\* Glory to Your resurrection, O Christ!\* Glory to Your kingdom!\* Glory to Your saving plan,\* O only Lover of mankind.

Troparion (Tone 8): Raised in virtue, O Father Theodosius,\* from childhood you loved the monastic life\* and attained your desire courageously.\* You lived in a cave adorning your life with fasting and radiance\* and abided in prayer like the bodiless powers.\* You shone like a beacon in the land of Rus'.\* Entreat Christ God to save our souls.

Troparion (Tone 4): O peoples, dance with joy and clap your hands with fervour.\* Gather today in eagerness and jubilation, and sing with glee;\* for the Mother of God is about to rise in glory,\* going up from the earth into heaven.\* it is to her we always sing hymns of praise,\* for she is the Mother of God.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion (Tone 4): Today the whole universe dances with joy\* at your glorious memory, O Mother of God,\* and it cries out to you:\* Rejoice, O virgin, pride of Christians.

Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Kontakion (Tone 3): Today we revere the star of Rus', blessed Theodosius,\* who shone from the east and same to the West;\* for he enriched this whole land and all of us\* with gentleness and miraculous wonders\* by the practice and the grace of the monastic rule. *Prokeimenon* (Tone 1): Let Your mercy, O Lord, be upon us, as we have hoped in You.

Verse: Rejoice in the Lord, O you just; praise befits the righteous. (Psalm 32:22,1)

Prokeimenon, (Tone 7): Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His venerable ones.

Epistle: 1 Corinthians 4:9-16 (NRSV)

Brothers and Sisters, for I think that God has exhibited us apostles as last of all, as though sentenced to death, because we have become a spectacle to the world, to angels and to mortals. We are fools for the sake of Christ, but you are wise in Christ. We are

weak, but you are strong. You are held in honor, but we in disrepute. To the present hour we are hungry and thirsty, we are poorly clothed and beaten and homeless, and we grow weary from the work of our own hands. When reviled, we bless; when persecuted, we endure; when slandered, we speak kindly. We have become like the rubbish of the world, the dregs of all things, to this very day. I am not writing this to make you ashamed, but to admonish you as my beloved children. For though you might have ten thousand



guardians in Christ, you do not have many fathers. Indeed, in Christ Jesus I became your father through the gospel. I appeal to you, then, be imitators of me.

#### Hebrews 13:7-16 (NRSV)

Brothers and Sisters, remember your leaders, those who spoke the word of God to you; consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith. Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever. Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings; for it is well for the heart to be strengthened by grace, not by regulations about food, which have not benefited those who observe them. We have an altar from which those who officiate in the tent have no right to eat. For the bodies of those animals whose blood is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest as a sacrifice for sin are burned outside the camp. Therefore Jesus also suffered outside the city gate in order to sanctify the people by his own blood. Let us then go to him outside the camp and bear the abuse he endured. For here we have no lasting city, but we are looking for the city that is to come. Through him, then, let us continually offer a sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of lips that confess his name. Do not neglect to do good and to share what you have, for such sacrifices are pleasing to God.

Gospel; Matthew 17:14-23 (NRSV)

At that time, when they came to the crowd, a man came to him, knelt before him, and said, "Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly; he often falls into the fire and often into the water. And I brought him to your disciples, but they could not cure him." Jesus answered, "You faithless and perverse generation, how much longer must I be with you? How much longer must I put up with you? Bring him here to me." And Jesus rebuked the demon, and it came out of him, and the boy was cured instantly. Then the disciples came to Jesus privately and said, "Why could we not cast it out?" He said to them, "Because of your little faith. For truly I tell you, if you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible for you." As they were gathering in Galilee, Jesus said to them, "The Son of Man is going to be betrayed into human hands, and they will kill him, and on the third day he will be raised." And they were greatly distressed.

#### Matthew 11:27-29 (NRSV)

The Lord said to his disciples, all things have been handed over to me by my Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father, and no one knows the Father except the Son and anyone to whom the Son chooses to reveal him. "Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

Апостол: (1Корінтян 4, 9-16):

Браття і Сестри, Бог поставив нас, апостолів, останніх, немов призначених на страту; ми бо стали видовищем і світові, і ангелам, і людям. Ми нерозумні Христа ради, ви у Христі розумні, ми немічні, ви сильні; ви славні, ми без слави. До цього часу ми голодні і спраглі, і нагі, нас б'ють, ми скитаємось; ми трудимося, власними руками; нас ображають, і ми благословляємо; нас гонять, і ми терпимо; нас лають, і ми доброзичливі; ми стали сміттям світу, викидками всіх аж досі. Пишу це не щоб осоромити вас, але щоб як дітей моїх улюблених навести на розум. Бо хоч би ви мали тисячі учителів у Христі, але батьків небагато, я бо вас породив через Євангеліє у Христі Ісусі. Благаю, отже, вас: Будьте моїми наслідувачами, як і я Христа.

Євр. 13, 7-16.

Браття і Сестри, пам'ятайте про наставників ваших, які звіщали вам слово Боже, і, дивлячись уважно на кінець їхнього життя, наслідуйте їхню віру. Ісус Христос учора й сьогодні — той самий навіки. Не дайте себе звести різними та чужими науками; воно бо добре укріпити серце благодаттю, не стравами, які не принесли ніякої користи тим, що їх тримались. У нас є жертовник, з якого не мають права їсти ті, що при наметі служать. Бо м'ясо тих звірят, кров яких первосвященик вносив у святиню за гріхи, палиться за табором. Тому й Ісус, щоб освятити народ власною кров'ю, страждав поза містом. Вийдімо, отже, до нього поза табір, несучи наругу його, бо ми не маємо тут постійного міста, але майбутнього шукаємо. За його посередництвом приносімо завжди Богові жертву хвали, тобто плід уст, які визнають його ім'я. Добродійства та взаємної щедроти не забувайте: такі бо жертви Богові приємні.

Євангеліє: (Мт 17, 14-23):

У той час якийсь чоловік приступив до Ісуса і, припавши йому до ніг, каже: Господи, змилуйся над моїм сином, бо він причинний і тяжко нездужає: часто кидається в огонь, часто й у воду. Я був привів його до твоїх учнів, та вони не могли його зцілити. Роде невірний та розбещений, — відповів Ісус, — доки я маю бути з вами? Приведіть мені його сюди! Ісус погрозив йому, і біс вийшов з хлопця; і юнак видужав тієї ж хвилі. 19. Тоді підійшли учні до Ісуса насамоті й спитали: Чому ми не могли його вигнати? Ісус сказав їм: Через вашу малу віру; бо істинно кажу вам: коли матимете віру, як зерно гірчиці, скажете цій горі: перенесися звідси туди — і вона перенесеться; і нічого не буде для вас неможливого. А щодо цього роду бісів, то його виганяють лише молитвою і постом. Як вони зібралися в Галилеї, Ісус сказав до них: Син чоловічий має бути виданий у руки людям, і вони його уб'ють, але третього дня він воскресне. І вони тяжко зажурились.

### Pope Francis teaches about Llfe.....

18.09.16 Angelus, St Peter's Square, Rome 25th Sunday of Ordinary Time Year C Luke 16: 1-13

Dear Brothers and Sisters, Good morning!

Today, Jesus invites us to reflect on two opposing ways of <u>life</u>: the way of the world and that of the Gospel — the <u>worldly spirit</u> is not the spirit of Jesus — and He does so by recounting the parable of the unfaithful and corrupt steward, who is praised by Jesus, despite his dishonesty (cf. Lk 16:1-13). We must point out immediately that this administrator is not presented as a model to follow, but as an example of deceitfulness. This man is accused of mismanaging his master's affairs, and before being removed, astutely he tries to ingratiate himself with the debtors, condoning part of their debt so as to ensure himself a future. Commenting on this behaviour, Jesus observes: "For the sons of this world are wiser in their own generation than the sons of light" (v. 8).



We are called to respond to this worldly astuteness with Christian astuteness, which is a gift of the Holy Spirit. This is a matter of departing from the worldly spirit and values, which the <u>devil</u> really favours, in order to live according to the Gospel. How is worldliness

manifested? Worldliness is manifested by attitudes of corruption, deception, subjugation, and it constitutes the most ill-chosen road, the road of sin, because one leads you to the other! It's like a chain, even if — it's true — it is generally the easiest road to travel. Instead, the spirit of the Gospel requires a serious lifestyle — serious but joyful, full of joy! — serious and challenging, marked by honesty, fairness, respect for others and their dignity, and a sense of duty. And this is Christian astuteness!

The journey of life necessarily involves a choice between two roads: between honesty and dishonesty, between fidelity and infidelity, between selfishness and altruism, between good and evil. You can not waver between one and the other, because they move on different and conflicting forms of logic. The prophet Elijah said to the people of Israel that went on these two roads: "You are limping with both feet!" (cf. 1 Kings 18:21). It's a fine image. It is important to decide which direction to take and then, once you have chosen the right one, to walk it with enthusiasm and determination, trusting in God's grace and the support of His Spirit. The conclusion of the Gospel passage is powerful and categorical: "No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other" (Lk 16:13).

With this teaching, Jesus today urges us to make a clear choice between Him and the worldly spirit, between the logic of corruption, of the abuse of power and greed, and that of righteousness, meekness and sharing. Some people conduct themselves with corruption as they do with drugs: they think they can use it and stop when they want. It starts out small: a tip here, a bribe over there.... And between this and that, one's freedom is slowly lost. Corruption is also habit-forming, and generates poverty, exploitation, and suffering. How many victims there are in the world today! How many victims of this widespread corruption. But when we try to follow the Gospel logic of integrity, clarity in intentions and in behaviour, of fraternity, we become artisans of justice and we open horizons of hope for humanity. In gratuitousness and by giving of ourselves to our brothers and sisters, we serve the right master: God. May the Virgin Mary help us to choose at every opportunity and at all costs, the right way, even finding the courage to go against the tide, in order to follow Jesus and His Gospel.

# The occupiers use the peaceful atom as a weapon to intimidate Ukraine and the world, - Head of the UGCC


The biggest concern for Ukraine and the world is the events surrounding the Zaporizhzhia NPP, which Russians hit twice, damaging the power supply of the nuclear power unit. Today we received alarming news about the possibility of it being mined... The Head of the Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Church, His Beatitude Sviatoslav, said this in his daily military address on August 6, the 164th day of the unequal battle against the Russian occupier, the battle for the freedom of the sovereign Ukrainian state.

"The occupiers use the peaceful atom as a weapon to intimidate Ukraine and the world. I call on all international institutions to respond to such terrorist behavior of the occupier on Ukrainian land!" The Primate emphasized.

Unfortunately, as the Head of the Church noted, the Ukrainian land again shuddered, hit by Russian bombs and missiles during the last day. Many were killed and wounded.

His Beatitude Sviatoslav thanked all Ukrainian men who are fighting for the victory of Ukraine, each in his place. "I am deeply moved when watching many of our boys storm military commissariats and being offended when they are not taken into the army. They feel guilty for being at the home front instead of the front line. I am grateful to all of you, patriots of Ukraine! Be where our Lord placed you, and bring Ukraine's victory over the enemy closer every day," said the Head of the UGCC.

It should be noted that on the morning of August 6, the 4th power unit of the Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plant stopped working. It



The high-voltage communication line of the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant (the largest one in Europe) is on fire after three powerful blasts. This, however, wasn't enough for the occupiers, who turned the nuclear facility into a military base. In the evening of the same day, the nitrogen-oxygen station near one of the power units was hit. The Rashists seriously damaged the station and the auxiliary block. The representatives of "Energoatom" stated that this could cause a fire and leakage of radioactive substances and hydrogen.

The Insider notes that the occupiers might have mined the ZNPP or the surrounding area. They published footage showing Russian military trucks entering the territory of the station and unloading some cargo. The British Ministry of Defense suggests that the Russians use the nuclear power plant as a cover and a staging ground for shelling Nikopol.

"Russian forces are using the nuclear power plant's protected status to reduce the risk to their equipment and personnel from nighttime attacks by Ukrainian forces," the statement reads.



This is a direct violation of nuclear security around the world, the head of European diplomacy, Jose Borrell, is convinced. "The EU condemns Russia's military activities around the Zaporizhia NPP. This is a grave and irresponsible violation of nuclear safety rules and another example of Russia's disregard for international norms. The IAEA must get access to the plant," he assures.

The other day, the IAEA, the world's main controller of nuclear safety, announced that it no longer controls the situation in Energodar. And this has nothing to do with the technical aspect. Director of the IAEA, Raphael Grossi, says that he is preparing a team to investigate the situation at the ZNPP.

Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelensky called on the world to do everything to expel the Russians from the Ukrainian nuclear power plant. In his address, he once again emphasized that the occupiers' presence at the nuclear facility and transformation of the latter into a military base is an act of terror. The representatives of "Energoatom" note that the Ukrainian personnel at the station work literally at gunpoint and make every effort to prevent any accidents. According to various sources, up to half a thousand Russian military personnel are currently stationed on the territory of the ZNPP.

On August 6, in the evening, the Russian missiles again hit the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant site and the city of Energodar. They hit the site of the ZNPP directly next to the station's ventilated spent nuclear fuel storage facility. Apparently, they aimed specifically at the SNF containers stored in the open near the sites of shelling. 174 containers, each containing 24 assemblies of spent nuclear fuel," the message reads.

It is noted that three radiation monitoring sensors around the SNF ventilated storage casks of the Zaporizhzhia NPP were damaged due to enemy rocket attacks. Therefore, timely detection and response in the event of deterioration of the radiation situation or leakage of radiation from SNF containers is currently impossible, emphasized Energoatom.

# Head of the UGCC to refugee mothers on the 169<sup>th</sup> day of the war: Think about Ukraine, and when the time is right, return home

You, mother, are the only seagull, watching over your child's welfare today. Please think about Ukraine, and when the time is right, return home. Ukraine needs all of you. Ukraine, your Motherland, miss you, cry, pray for you. And we believe that the day will come when your father will return home alive from the front, you and your children from abroad, and then your family will reunite. And we will be together again in our native, independent, free Ukraine! The Father and Head of the UGCC, His Beatitude Sviatoslav, said in his daily address on the 169th day of Russia's war against Ukraine.



From daily news, with which His Beatitude Sviatoslav began his address, we hear that Ukraine was again severely wounded by Russian weapons of various types: "The enemy is tirelessly trying to attack Ukrainian troops, particularly, in Luhansk and Donetsk regions. Our already wounded cities of Kharkiv and Mykolaiv shudder under Russian missiles and bombs. However, the last night was the most hellish in the Dnipropetrovsk region. The enemy destroyed many civilian houses with jet artillery strikes, damaged the infrastructure of large cities. Ukrainian blood was shed again..."

But Ukraine stands! Ukraine fights! Ukraine prays!

His Beatitude Sviatoslav explained that a person is a social being by her nature and is created in the image and likeness of God, who is the Trinity. Therefore, she needs all kinds of

benefits she cannot provide for herself.

"The common good is not just the sum of various private goods or prosperity of the citizens of this or that state. It is something that can be achieved only together, jointly, enabling all citizens to feel protected in society and the state. Each person, as a citizen, has particular responsibilities for the common good. For example, we say that the purpose of serving any political power in the country is the common good of all citizens. An example of such a good is the state itself. We also know we can defeat the enemy only when we stand together. And we understand that the victory of Ukraine will be the common good of the entire Ukrainian people. It is the good that will be used by all citizens today, our children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren in the future," the Primate pointed out.

In today's address, His Beatitude Sviatoslav appealed especially to the mothers who, together with their children, were forced to flee Ukraine while their husbands remained to protect it.

"The whole world was moved by the photo in which the father brought his wife and child to the border, said goodbye to them, and returned to defend the Motherland. And the mother and the child continued hard, uncertain way of the refugee," he noted. "Dear mothers, today we pray for you especially. I want to express my words of support to you. We remember you. We pray for you. Today, you, mother, are the only protection for your child in that foreign world, the only door to this big and unknown, sometimes alien world. You, mother, being there, in a foreign land, are the only ones who should take care of the Christian and equally the national and cultural upbringing of your child. And we, as a community, the Church, want to help. Our parishes and communities in different countries of the world, where you are, in particular, want to be close to you, to surround you with the warmth of solidarity and Christian love."

"O God, bless the Ukrainian people! Bless Ukrainian mothers! Bless the Ukrainian army - our sons and daughters, who are building the common good of the Ukrainian people, with their own lives bringing this desired victory closer every day. God, bless Ukraine with Your just God's heavenly peace!" asked the Head of the Church.


