Liturgical propers in English language:

Tone 4, text from book "The Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom"; pages 95-97

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Romans: (Romans 10:1-10)

Brothers and Sisters, my heart's desire, my prayer to God for the Israelites, is that they may be saved. Indeed, I can testify that they are zealous for God though their zeal is unenlightened. Unaware of God's justice and seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the justice of God. Christ is the end of the law. Through him, justice comes to everyone who believes. Moses writes of the justice that comes from the law, 'The one who observes the law

shall live by it.' But of the justice that comes from faith he says, 'Do not say in your heart, "Who shall go up into heaven?" (that is, to bring Christ down), or "Who shall go down into the abyss?" (that is, to bring Christ up from the dead). What is it he does say? 'The word is near you, on your lips and in your heart' (that is, the word of faith that we preach). For if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Faith in the heart leads to justification, confession on the lips to salvation.

Gospel: (Matthew 8:28-9:1)

At that time, as Jesus approached the Gadarene boundary, he encountered two men coming out of the tombs. They were possessed by demons and were so savage that no one could travel along that road. With a sudden shriek they cried, 'Why meddle with us, Son of God? Have you come to torture us before the appointed time?' Some distance away a large herd of swine was feeding. The demons kept appealing to him, 'If you expel us, send us into the herd of swine.' He answered, 'Out with you!' At they came forth and entered the swine. The whole herd went rushing down the bluff into the sea and were drowned. The swineherds took to their heels, and upon their arrival in the town related everything that had happened, including the story about the two possessed men. The upshot was that the entire town came out to meet Jesus. When they caught sight of him, they begged him to leave their neighborhood. Then he reentered the boat, made the crossing, and came back to his own town.

Бо якщо устами твоїми будеш сповідувати Ісуса Господом і серцем твоїм вірувати, що Бог воскресив Його з мертвих, то врятуєшся; Тому що серцем вірують для праведности, а вустами сповідують для порятунку.

<u>Євангеліє</u>: (Мт. 8, 28-9, 1)

У той час, коли Ісус прибув на той бік, у край гадаринський, зустріли його два біснуваті, що вийшли з гробниць, але такі люті, що ніхто не міг перейти тією дорогою. <u>SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS</u>: Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. *If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*

<u>Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry</u>: Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment. Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time. Holy Unction (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time). Funerals and Memorials: by appointment.

On Monday, June 26, the Father and Head of the UGCC, His Beatitude Sviatoslav, led the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy marking the All-Ukrainian pilgrimage to Stradch. Hundreds of pilgrims gathered for the pilgrimage dedicated to Laity Day and the blessed new martyrs of the UGCC, Fr. Mykola Konrad and deacon Volodymyr Pryima. People were especially praying for the Ukrainian army and fallen heroes.

The Commenting on the Gospel passage, His Beatitude Sviatoslav says that there

must have been many who came to see the miracles of Jesus Christ as bystanders, not participants.

"God is not looking for spectators, but for companions," said the Head of the Church, "And then the Lord tells us how a person can participate in this power of God. He speaks strange words that have been the subject of contemplation, reflection, and centuries of Christian thinking.'

Very often today, people expect God to do everything for them; they want to be an unbiased spectator of someone who would make them happy instead.

"Believing in God does not mean having some extraordinary ability to manipulate Him, to force Him to do my will through some long prayer or asceticism," said His Beatitude Sviatoslav, "No, Christian faith is a task, a vocation, a call to action, a call to partake in the feat that is possible only in God and with Him."

Today, the word of God about the expression of God's extraordinary almightiness and the call of man to cooperate is life-giving for the Ukrainian people, who are fighting for their right to exist, defending their freedom, and fighting for their free and independent state. His Beatitude Sviatoslav said today it is essential not to let ourselves be indulged by what divides us and not to become just a spectator looking at the feat of our heroes. It is a high risk, particularly for those living in relatively peaceful areas.

After the Liturgy, His Beatitude Sviatoslav thanked the clergy and laity who gathered in large numbers for the pilgrimage — a joint prayer of the strength of the Ukrainian people.

During the pilgrimage, the Head of the UGCC had the opportunity to communicate with the families of the fallen Ukrainian heroes from the Yavoriv district. The families of the fallen soldiers presented His Beatitude Sviatoslav with a gift — a chest with shawls, which are symbols of the mothers and wives of soldiers who gave their lives for the Motherland and asked him to continue praying for the soldiers and fallen heroes of Ukraine. After the Liturgy, His Beatitude Sviatoslav consecrated the Spiritual and Psychological Rehabilitation Center named after His Beatitude Lubomyr Husar in Stradch.

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
