Liturgical propers in English language:

Troparion, Tone 7: By Your cross You destroyed death;* You opened Paradise to the thief;* You changed the lamentation of the myrrh-bearers to joy,* and charged the apostles to proclaim* that You are risen, O Christ our God,* offering great mercy to the world.

Troparion, Tone 4: You appeared as a radiant light,* O priest-martyr Josaphat.* Like the Good Shepherd, you lay down your life for your sheep;* killed by enemies who loved division, you entered the holy of holies to dwell with the bodiless powers.*Therefore we pray you, long-suffering saint:* beg Christ, the Prince of Shepherds,* to number us among the sheep at His right hand and to save our souls.

Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, Tone 7: No longer shall the dominion of death be able to hold humanity,* for Christ went down shattering and destroying it's powers.* Hades is bound.* The prophets exult with one voice.* The Saviour has come for those with faith, saying:* "Come forth, O faithful, to the resurrection!"

Kontakion, Tone 4: Enlightened in childhood* by the flame from the crucified Christ,* you resembled the angels in your life as a monk,* and as bishop you lived in godliness.* You clearly preached unity and with your martyr's blood, you calmed hearts inflamed by love for dispute.* From Christ you received the crown.* And so remember us as we cry to you:* Rejoice, O unshakeable pillar of unity.

Prokeimenon, Tone 7: The Lord will give strength to His people;* the Lord will bless His people with peace.

Verse: Bring to the Lord, O you sons of God; bring to the Lord young rams. (Psalm 28:11,1)

Prokeimenon, Tone 7: Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His venerable ones.

Epistle: Ephesians 2:14-22

For he is our peace; in his flesh he has made both groups into one and has broken down the dividing wall, that is, the hostility between us. He has abolished the law with its commandments and ordinances, that he might create in himself one new humanity in place of the two, thus making peace, and might reconcile both groups to God in one body through the cross, thus putting to death that hostility through it. So he came and proclaimed peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near; for through him both of us have access in one Spirit to the Father. So then you are no longer strangers and aliens, but you are citizens with the saints and also members of the household of God, built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the cornerstone. In him the whole structure is joined together and grows into a holy temple in the Lord; in whom you also are built together spiritually into a dwelling place for God.

Epistle: Hebrews 4:14-5:10

Since, then, we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast to our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who in every respect has been tested as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore approach the throne of grace with boldness, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Every high priest chosen from among mortals is put in charge of things pertaining to God on their behalf, to offer gifts and sacrifices for sins. He is able to deal gently with the ignorant and wayward, since he himself is subject to weakness; and because of this he must offer sacrifice for his own sins as well as for those of the people. And one does not presume to take this honor, but takes it only when called by God, just as Aaron was.

So also Christ did not glorify himself in becoming a high priest, but was appointed by the one who said to him, "You are my Son, today I have begotten you"; as he says also in another place, "You are a priest forever, according to the order of Melchizedek." In the days of his flesh, Jesus offered up prayers and supplications, with loud cries and tears, to the one who was able to save him from death, and he was heard because of his reverent submission. Although he was a Son, he learned obedience through what he suffered; and having been made perfect, he became the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him, having been designated by God a high priest according to the order of Melchizedek.

Gospel: Luke 8:41-56; John 10:9-16

Just then there came a man named Jairus, a leader of the synagogue. He fell at Jesus' feet and begged him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years old, who was dying. As he went, the crowds pressed in on him. Now there was a woman who had been suffering from hemorrhages for twelve years; and though she had spent all she had on physicians, no one could cure her. She came up behind him and touched the fringe of his clothes, and immediately her hemorrhage stopped. Then Jesus asked, "Who touched me?" When all denied it, Peter said, "Master, the crowds surround you and press in on you." But Jesus said, "Someone touched me; for I noticed that power had gone out from me." When the woman saw that she could not remain hidden, she came trembling; and falling down before him, she declared in the presence of all the people why she had touched him, and how she had been immediately healed. He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace."

While he was still speaking, someone came from the leader's house to say, "Your daughter is dead; do not trouble the teacher any longer." When Jesus heard this, he replied, "Do not fear. Only believe, and she will be saved." When he came to the house, he did not allow anyone to enter with him, except Peter, John, and James, and the child's father and mother. They were all weeping and wailing for her; but he said, "Do not weep; for she is not dead but sleeping." And they laughed at him, knowing that she was dead. But he took her by the hand and called out, "Child, get up!" Her spirit returned, and she got up at once. Then he directed them to give her something to eat. Her parents were astounded; but he ordered them to tell no one what had happened.

Gospel: John 10:9-16

I am the gate. Whoever enters by me will be saved, and will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.

"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand, who is not the shepherd and does not own the sheep, sees the wolf coming and leaves the sheep and runs away—and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. The hired hand runs away because a hired hand does not care for the sheep. I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father. And I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. I must bring them also, and they will listen to my voice. So there will be one flock, one shepherd.

Прокімен (глас 7): Чесна перед Господом смерть преподобних Його (Пс. 115,6).

Апостол: (Еф 2,14-22):

Браття і Сестри, Христос — наш мир, він, що зробив із двох одне, зруйнувавши стіну, яка була перегородою, тобто ворожнечу, — своїм тілом скасував закон заповідей у своїх рішеннях, на те, щоб із двох зробити в собі одну нову людину, вчинивши мир між нами, і щоб примирити їх обох в однім тілі з Богом через хрест, убивши ворожнечу в ньому. Він прийшов звістувати мир вам, що були далеко, і мир тим, що були близько; бо через нього, одні й другі, маємо доступ до Отця в однім Дусі. Отже ж ви більше не чужинці і не приходні, а співгромадяни святих і домашні Божі, побудовані на підвалині апостолів і пророків, де наріжним каменем — сам Ісус Христос. На ньому вся будівля, міцно споєна, росте святим храмом у Господі; на ньому ви теж будуєтеся разом на житло Бога в Дусі.

Апостол: (Євр4, 14 – 5, 6.)

Браття і Сестри, Браття, маючи великого архиєрея, що пройшов небо, Ісуса, Божого Сина, тримаймося твердо віровизнання. Бо ми не маємо такого архиєрея, який не міг би співчувати нашим недугам; він бо зазнав усього подібно, як і ми, крім гріха. Приступім, отже, з довір'ям до престолу благодаті, щоб отримати милость і найти благодать для своєчасної помочі. Кожен бо архиєрей, узятий з-між людей, настановляється для людей у справах Божих, щоб приносив дари та жертви за гріхи, щоб міг співчувати нетямущим та тим, що заблудили, бо й сам він ввесь у немочах, і тому має як за людей, так і за себе самого приносити жертви за гріхи. Достоїнства ж цього ніхто не бере собі, але той, хто покликаний Богом, як Арон. Так і Христос не сам собі присвоїв славу стати архиєреєм, бо вона від того, який до нього мовив: Син мій єси, я сьогодні родив тебе. Як і на іншому місці каже: Ти священик навіки по чину Мелхиседека.

Стих: Добре вого – прославляти Господа, і співати Твоєму імені, Вс евишній (Пс 91,2).

Стих: Звіщати вранці Твою милість, ночами – Твою вірність (Пс 91,3).

Стих: Священики Твої зодягнуться в праведність і преподобні Твої возрадуються (Пс. 131,9).

Стих: Праведник, як фінік, розцвіте і, як кедр на Ливані, виросте (Пс. 91,13).

Євангеліє: (Луки 8.41-56):

У той час один чоловік приступив до Ісуса, Яір на ім'я, який був головою синагоги. Припавши до ніг Ісуса, він почав його просити зайти до нього в хату, бо була в нього дочка одиначка, яких дванадцять років, і вона вмирала. І як він ішов туди, люди тиснулися до нього. Аж тут жінка якась, що була хвора дванадцять років на кровотечу й витратила на лікарів увесь свій прожиток, і ніхто з них не міг її оздоровити, підійшовши ззаду, доторкнулась краю його одежі й умить стала здоровою — спинилась її кровотеча. Ісус спитав: "Хто доторкнувся мене?" А що всі відпекувались, Петро мовив: "Наставниче, то люди коло тебе юрмляться і тиснуться." Ісус же сказав: "Хтось доторкнувся до мене, бо я чув, як сила вийшла з мене." Побачивши жінка, що не втаїлася, тремтячи підійшла й упавши йому до ніг, призналася перед усіма людьми, чому до нього доторкнулась і як негайно одужала. Сказав їй Ісус: "Дочко, віра твоя спасла тебе, йди в мирі!" Він говорив ще, як приходить хтось від голови синагоги і каже: "Твоя дочка померла, не турбуй більш Учителя." Ісус почувши це, озвався до нього: "Не бійся, тільки віруй, і вона спасеться." Прийшовши до хати, він не пустив нікого з собою всередину,

крім Петра, Йоана та Якова з батьком та матір'ю дитини. Всі плакали за нею і голосили. Він же мовив: "Не плачте, вона не вмерла, вона тільки спить." І ті сміялися з нього, бо знали, що вмерла. А він узяв її за руку й голосно промовив: "Дівчино, пробудися!" І дух її повернувсь до неї, і вона миттю встала. Тоді він звелів дати їй їсти. Батьки ж її були здивовані вельми, та він наказав їм нікому не говорити, що сталося.

<u>Євангеліє</u>: (Івана 10, 9-16.)

Сказав Господь юдеям, які до нього прийшли: Я – ворота. Хто ввійде через мене, спасеться. Він увійде, вийде і найде пасовисько. Злодій не приходить, хіба щоб красти, вбивати, вигублювати. Я прийшов, щоб мали життя і мали його вповні. Я – добрий пастир. Добрий пастир життя своє дав за овець. 12. Наймит, який не пастир і якому вівці не належать, бачить вовка, що надходить, і кидає вівці та біжить геть; і вовк хапає їх і розполохує. Наймит же втікає, бо він наймит і не дбає про вівці. Я – добрий пастир і знаю моїх, і мої мене знають. Отець мій знає мене, і я знаю Отця; я життя моє кладу за мої вівці. Ще й інші вівці маю, що не з цієї кошари; і їх мушу привести: вони почують мій голос, і буде одне стадо й один пастир.



Pope Francis blessed the decision of the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic Church in appointing Most Rev. Bishop Michael Kwiatkowski as 4th Eparchial Bishop of the Eparchy of New Westminster. Bishop Michael will be enthroned (installed) on November 18th at Protection of the Most Holy Mother of God Parish, Vancouver, followed by his First Solemn Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at Holy Eucharist Cathedral, New Westminster, on November 19th, 2023 A.D.

Episcopal Coat of Arms of Bishop Michael Kwiatkowski of New Westminster

Bishop Michael wanted three basic images and themes to be included in his coat of arms: the Our Lord through the Holy Eucharist, by which we profoundly become one with Christ and find the source and summit of our Faith (Christ our Pascha, 390); the Mother of God, especially his favourite icon of the Mother of God of Vysh'horod – ever interceding for God's People; and the Archangel Michael, his life-long patron and the one who defends the glory of God. The motto chosen is the concluding phrase of Joshua 24:15, "We Will Serve the Lord"

These three images were developed by the President of the Ukrainian Heraldy Society of Ukraine, Dr. Andriy Hrechylo, to be represented by appropriate symbols. The three 8-pointed stars on a field of blue as would be found on icons of the Mother of God representing her purity and ever-virginity. The sword and scales of the Archangel Michael who defeats evil and has a role in the judgement of souls. The Holy Eucharist is represented almost identically to the symbol of "Lamb" host and Chalice as depicted on the coat of arms of the Eparchy of New Westminster.

The surrounding mitre, mantle, staff and processional cross signify the episcopal office.


Епископський герб Владики Михайла Квятковського, спарха Ню-Вестмінстерського

Владика Михаїл хотів, щоб на його гербі були три основні образи і теми: Господь наш через Пресвяту Євхаристію, через яку ми глибоко з'єднуємося з Христом і знаходимо джерело і вершину нашої віри (Христою — наша Пасха, 390); Божа Матір, особливо його улюблена ікона Вишгородської Богородиці — неостанна заступниця Божого народу; і Архистратиг Михаїл, його покровитель і той, хто захищає славу Божу. Обраним девізом є заключна фраза Ісуса Навина 24:15 «[А я та дім мій] Служитимемо Господеві»

Ці три зображення розроблені президентом Українського Геральдичного Товариства д-ром Андрієм Гречилом для представлення відповідними символами. Три 8-кутні зірочки на блакитному полі, як і на іконах Божої Матері, символізують її чистоту і непорочності. Меч і ваги Архангела Михаїла, який перемагає зло і бере участь у суді над душами. Пресвята Євхаристія представлена майже ідентично символу «Агнпя» та Чаші, як зображено на гербі Єпархії Нью-Вестмінстера.

Навколишні символи митри, мантії, жезла та процесійного хреста означають єпископський стан.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Friends,

I have received an email from Bishop-Elect Very Rev. Michael Kwiatkowski with a special request from each one of us. He is asking each and everyone of us to pray for him as he prepares to receive his Episcopal Ordination on November 8th in Winnipeg, MB and then to begin his episcopal ministry in our Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of New Westminster on November 18th, 2023 A.D.

Manitoba-Born Priest Ordained as Ukrainian Catholic Bishop for New Westminster Eparchy

On a significant day of November 7, 2023, in the heart of Winnipeg, Reverend Michael Kwiatkowski, a native of Manitoba, was ordained as the fourth bishop of the Eparchy of New Westminster for the Ukrainian Catholic Church. The solemn ceremony took place at 6 p.m. at the magnificent Sts. Volodymyr and Olha Ukrainian Catholic Metropolitan Cathedral, where the newly ordained bishop donned imported silver and white vestments.

What makes this event particularly special is that Bishop Kwiatkowski is soon to embark on a new chapter of his service on the West Coast in British Columbia. Despite his impending relocation to British Columbia, he chose Winnipeg as the venue for his ordination, surrounded by colleagues, parishioners, and family who came to support him on this momentous occasion.



As he reflected on the choice of location, the humble farmer's son from Elphinstone expressed his joy, saying, "I'm so glad the ordination is here, so a lot of family and friends can attend." This heartfelt sentiment highlighted the importance of community and family in his life and ministry.

The bilingual English-Ukrainian service was graced by the presence of Winnipeg's two Roman Catholic bishops. Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak of the Ukrainian Catholic Archeparchy of Winnipeg presided over the ceremony, adding to the significance of the event.

Bishop Kwiatkowski's journey to becoming a bishop is a testament to his dedicated service to the Ukrainian Catholic Church. After his ordination to the priesthood in 1986, he served in various roles, including as a parish priest, vice-rector at a Ukrainian university, director of spiritual formation at a seminary in Ottawa, and earning a doctorate in Eastern Canon Law in 2000 from the Pontifical Oriental Institute in Rome. This extensive experience and deep commitment to his faith have paved the way for his new role as bishop.

The Eparchy of New Westminster, located in British Columbia, encompasses a vast region, including Vancouver Island, the Lower Mainland, the Okanagan, and parts of northern British Columbia, as well as the Yukon. Although it is the smallest of the five Ukrainian Catholic eparchies in Canada in terms of registered members, it covers a significant geographical area.

The journey of Reverend Michael Kwiatkowski, from his roots in Manitoba to becoming the fourth bishop of the Eparchy of New Westminster, is a testament to his faith and dedication to his calling. As he embarks on this new chapter of his life and ministry in British Columbia, the Ukrainian Catholic Church in Canada welcomes him with open arms and high hopes for the spiritual leadership he will provide in his new role. On November 18, Bishop Kwiatkowski will be officially installed in Vancouver, and the next day, he will lead his first divine liturgy as bishop of New Westminster, marking the beginning of a new era for the Eparchy.

У Вінніпезі відбулася архиєрейська хіротонія владики Михайла Квятковського

8 листопада 2023 року в катедральному соборі Святих Володимира та Ольги у Вінніпезі (Канада) відбулася Божественна Літургія з Чином архиєрейської хіротонії владики Михайла Квятковського. Її очолив митрополит Вінніпезький Лаврентій Гуцуляк — головний святитель. Співсвятителями стали владика Борис Ґудзяк, митрополит Філадельфійський, і владика Давид Мотюк, правлячий єпископ Едмонтонської єпархії.

Передовсім владика Михайло тричі публічно склав визнання віри. Після цього відбувся Чин архиєрейської хіротонії. Нововисвяченого єпископа одягли в архиєрейські ризи, а митрополит Лаврентій вручив йому архиєрейський жезл як символ єпископської влади.

Під час Літургії владика Лаврентій привітав усіх вірних, зокрема єпископів, які прибули на єпископську хіротонію владики Михайла. «Блаженніший Патріарх Святослав, який має канонічне право висвячувати всіх єпископів для Української Католицької Церкви, делегував мені, як митрополитові, звершити цю хіротонію, оскільки його щільний графік, насамперед з огляду на війну в Україні, не дає йому змоги зробити це особисто. Цю хіротонію зі мною здійснюють два єпискописпівсвятителі: митрополит Філадельфійський Борис Ґудзяк, який багато років працював із владикою Михайлом в Україні, та єпископ Давид Мотюк, який був апостольським адміністратором Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії після призначення владики Новаківського до Лондона», — зазначив головний святитель.

Пояснивши вірним значення кожної з частин єпископської хіротонії, митрополит Вінніпезький звернувся до нововисвяченого владики словами Глави УГКЦ із Декрету іменування його правлячим єпископом Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії: «Дорогий брате! Сьогодні Ви долучаєтеся до грона владик Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії, які у своєму служінні виконували Божу волю, "щоб усі люди спаслися і прийшли до розуміння правди". Збережіть і примножте їхню працю, дорогий владико! Це служіння виконуватимете відповідно до Кодексу канонів Східних Церков, партикулярних законів Української Греко-Католицької Церкви. Заохочуємо Вас, згідно з повчанням Апостола народів, щоб Ви були "бездоганним, гостинним, добролюбивим, мудрим, справедливим, благочестивим, стриманим, який дотримується правдивої науки згідно з навчанням... здібний наставляти в здоровій науці та й супротивників переконувати". Нагадуємо Вам про важкий обов'язок бути вірним членом Синоду Єпископів УГКЦ і, згідно із приписами права, на кожний заклик Отця і Глави Церкви брати в ньому участь. Закликаємо Вас берегти й утверджувати віру та віддано працювати для спасіння душ наших вірних. Прислухайтеся до духовенства та мирян ввіреної Вам єпархії».

Відтак, звертаючись до духовенства і вірних Нью-Вестмінстерської єпархії, митрополит Лаврентій продовжив: «Просимо духовенство та боголюбивих мирян єпархії з відкритим і щирим серцем, із пошаною і любов'ю прийняти преосвященного владику Михайла. Духовенство закликаємо виявляти Вам належний послух у служінні Христові, Його Святій Церкві й Божому людові, щоб ширилося слово Христової істини в усій єпархії на славу Святої, Єдиносущної, Животворної і Нероздільної Тройці, Отця, і Сина, і Святого Духа».

У подячному слові англійською мовою нововисвячений єпископ Михайло подякував усім, хто супроводжував його на шляху покликання та служіння: батькам, братам і сестрам та всій родині; отцям редемптористам і співбратам зі семінарійних часів у Манітобі, між ними — владиці Браянові Байді, з яким разом навчалися у коледжі Святого Володимира, а також тогочасному ректору владиці Петрові Стасюку; отцям василіанам і співбратам Папської української колегії святого Йосафата в Римі; отцям домініканцям з Анджелікуму й отцям єзуїтам із Папського східного інституту; співбратам у священстві з Вінніпезькій архиєпархії; сестрам-монахиням різних згромаджень; а також співбратам у єпископстві митрополиту Максимові Германюку, архиєпископу Мирославові Марусину, головному святителю митрополиту Лаврентієві Гуцуляку, співсвятителям митрополиту Борисові Ґудзяку і владиці Давидові Мотюку, митрополиту Стефанові Сороці, римо-католицьким і православним єпископам, присутнім на хіротонії, а також усім єпископам Української Греко-Католицької Церкви та Єпископської конференції Канади.

Окремо владика Михайло згадав і блаженнішого Любомира Гузара, який покликав його до служіння у Патріаршій курії у Львові, і всіх людей, які з ним співпрацювали в цей час, зокрема в Українському католицькому університеті.

«Особливу вдячність хочу висловити ще двом єпископам, які не лише відіграли велику роль на початку мого нового служіння сьогодні, а й, знаю, моляться за мене в цей час: це — єпископ Рима Папа Франциск, який призначив мене єпископом Нью-Вестмінстера, і Верховний Архиєпископ Києво-Галицький Блаженніший Святослав, який разом зі Синодом Єпископів обрали мене й подали мою кандидатуру до Рима», — сказав владика Михайло.

Відтак закликав присутніх тримати Блаженнішого Святослава, нашу Церкву в Україні та стражденний український народ

у своїх молитвах.

Своє слово владика Михайло завершив перепрошенням усіх, кого, образив, можливо. і проханням про молитву за нього. щоб йому бути добрим і святим єпископом. «Прошу цього не лише для себе, але для всіх єпископів у всьому світі. Ми потребуємо величі і святості в наш час. Церква завжди потребує таких лідерів», додав архиєрей.

Завершилося урочисте богослужіння молитвою за Україну «Боже, великий, єдиний».


