Tone 2, text from book "The Divine Liturgy of Saint John Chrysostom"; pages 91-93

Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Ephesians: (Eph. 6:10-17)

Brothers and Sisters, draw your strength from the Lord and his mighty power. Put on the armor of God so that you may be able to stand firm against the tactics of the devil. Our battle is not against human forces but against the principalities and powers, the rulers of this world of darkness, the evil spirits in regions above. You must put on the armor of God if you are to resist on the evil day; do all that your duty requires, and hold your ground. Stand fast, with the truth as the belt around your waist, justice as your breastplate, and zeal to propagate the

gospel of peace as your footgear. In all circumstances hold faith up before you as your shield; it will help you extinguish the fiery darts of the evil one. Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the spirit, the word of God.

Gospel: (Luke 13:10-17)

At that time, Jesus was teaching in one of the synagogues. There was a woman there who for eighteen years had been possessed by a spirit which drained her strength. She was badly stooped – quite incapable of standing erect. When Jesus saw her, he called her to him and said, "Woman, you are free of your infirmity." He laid his hand on her, and immediately she stood up straight and began thanking God. The chief of the synagogue, indignant that Jesus should have healed on the Sabbath, said to the congregation, "There are six days for working. Come on those days to be cured, not on the Sabbath." The Lord said in reply, "O you hypocrites! Which of you does not let his ox or ass out of the stall on the Sabbath to water it? Should not this daughter of Abraham here who has been in the bondage of Satan for eighteen years have been released from her shackles on the Sabbath?" At these words, his opponents were covered with confusion; meanwhile, everyone else rejoiced at the marvels Jesus was accomplishing.

<u>SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS</u>: Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! We also pray for the people of Ukraine, that with the help of the Holy Spirit, they may obtain social peace, political harmony and economic stability: Lord, hear us and have mercy.

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.

<u>Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry</u>: Baptisms: by appointment. Marriages: six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. Reconciliation: by appointment. Holy Communion: for the sick, by appointment, any time. Holy Unction (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time). Funerals and Memorials: by appointment.



THE PARISH COUNCIL IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE A MAJOR RENOVATION OF THE PARISH HALL. This is a very exciting project and will provide our church with a beautiful facility to gather as a Christian family, host events, and rent out as a source of revenue. We are also pleased to report that the <u>full cost of the renovation was donated</u> by one of our parishioners, so <u>it will not financially impact our church</u>.

The parish hall was built in the '80s, and several items are in need of upgrading or complete replacement because they no longer work. This renovation will include the following items.

- Stretch ceiling to cover the spray-on ceiling, including LED lights and larger fans.
- Sand and refinish the hardwood floor.
- New electrical outlets, new light switches, and replace all the floor vents. Millwork to hide pipes and electrical.
- Paint all the walls and ceilings of the foyer, bathrooms, kitchen, and large hall walls.
- New LED lights in the kitchen, hall, and foyer.
- New swamp cooler in the kitchen, which currently is disconnected and not functional.
- Replace the main air conditioner unit in the hall, which is not working anymore, and extend the ducting to
 provide better cooling.
- Service the existing furnaces and clean out the entire ducting system, which has not been done in years!
- A new upgraded Audio and Visual package, including wireless microphones, Bluetooth connectivity, an automatic screen, and an HD projector mounted from the ceiling.
- New roller shades for the kitchen.
- Storage cabinets along the east wall by the kitchen, with countertops.
- Extended bar and kitchen counters.
- A new coffee station with upgraded coffee machines!
- Bathroom upgrades, including new LED lights, paint, and upgraded plumbing (which is currently below building code), along with new sinks and toilets.

In addition, THE FIRE INSPECTOR RECENTLY FAILED OUR ENTIRE FIRE ALARM SYSTEM as it is not functioning properly. This "fail" grade by the fire department means that if a fire damages our church, we will not be eligible for insurance coverage. As such, we will upgrade the entire system, including a new Fire Control Panel and 11 new smoke detectors, upgraded fire extinguishers, and a new fire suppression system in the kitchen, which currently does not work.

This exciting and necessary list of repairs and upgrades will take approximately 90 days to complete. We are going to start this project on <u>January 2</u>, <u>2024</u>, and will be done before Easter week on <u>March 24th</u>. <u>During this time</u>, the hall will <u>be inaccessible</u>. We appreciate your patience during this time and ask that you understand that several of these items need to be replaced and fixed. If you have any questions, please contact any member of the parish council.

PRESS RELEASE - APPOINTMENT OF BISHOP FOR SASKATOON EPARCHY

The Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Saskatoon is pleased to announce that following upon the proposal of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Synod of Bishops, Pope Francis has appointed Very Reverend Michael Smolinski, CSsR, until now Provincial Superior of the Redemptorists in Canada, as Bishop of the Eparchy of Saskatoon. This decision was announced from the Vatican on Thursday, November 30, 2023.

Bishop-Elect Smolinski becomes the 6th Eparchial Bishop to minister to the Ukrainian Catholic Faithful in the Province of Saskatchewan. Born and raised in Saskatoon, Bishop-Elect Smolinski served in pastoral ministry in Saskatchewan, as well as in Manitoba. For many years he directed The Welcome Home project for inner city residents in Winnipeg. Since January 2023, he was Provincial Superior for the combined English-Speaking, French-Speaking and Ukrainian Catholic Province for the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer – the Redemptorists.

Following the transfer of Bishop Bryan Bayda from Saskatoon to the Eparchy of Toronto and Eastern Canada in 2022, the Eparchy of Saskatoon was administered by Metropolitan Archbishop Lawrence Huculak of Winnipeg. Plans for the episcopal ordination and installation have not yet been finalized.

Українська Греко-Католицька Єпархія Саскатуну рада повідомити, що Папа Франциск, розглянувши пропозицію Синоду Єпископів Української Греко-Католицької Церкви, призначив преподобного отця Михайла Смолінського, ЧНІ, дотеперішнього Провінційного Настоятеля Редемптористів у Канаді, єпископом Саскатунської єпархії. Це рішення було оголошено у Ватикані в четвер, 30 листопада 2023 року. Новопризначений єпископ Михайло стане шостим єпархіальним єпископом, який буде служити українським греко- католикам у провінції Саскачеван.

Владика-номінант народився і виріс у Саскатуні та душпастирював у Саскачевані, а також у Манітобі. Багато років він керував місією «Запрошуємо додому» для мешканців міста Вінніпег. З січня 2023 року був вибраний провінційним настоятелем об'єднаної англомовної, франкомовної та української греко-католицької провінцій Канади для Згромадження Найсвятішого Ізбавителя — Редемптористів.

Після переведення єпископа Браяна Байди із Саскатуна до єпархії Торонто та Східної Канади у 2022 році, Саскатунську єпархію провадив архиєпископ Лаврентій Гуцуляк, митрополит Вінніпезький. Дата та місце єпископської хіротонії та інтронізації будуть оголошені пізніше.

Freedom sprouted from the grains hidden in the palms of our hands: 8 thoughts of UGCC bishops on the Holodomor



On November 25, Ukraine will commemorate the 90th anniversary of the Holodomor Genocide of 1932–1933. To mark this occasion, the Synod of Bishops of the UGCC in Ukraine addressed the clergy, monastics, and faithful. Here are eight main thoughts from the Appeal.

- 1. Totalitarian Moscow has always borne hatred for Ukraine, and the genocide by famine was the bloodiest embodiment of the centuries-old ideology of Russian imperialism.
- 2. The method of killing by starvation was chosen deliberately. To subdue a nation of millions, bayonets and tanks are not sufficient. Establishing long-lasting domination requires weapons of mass destruction that can sow fear among generations.
- 3. The Holodomor of the Ukrainian people is one of the greatest human catastrophes in history. In a letter to Ukrainians, Pope John Paul II wrote about the Holodomor as a wound that affected the foundations of all humanity (cf. Letter on the 70th anniversary of the Holodomor in Ukraine).
- 4. Russia's war against Ukraine has the same aim the liquidation of the Ukrainian people and the destruction of their freedom and future.
- 5. The impunity for evil never goes unpunished. Ninety years ago, the world silently watched the murder of millions of Ukrainians. It gave birth to another totalitarian regime, which led to the deaths of tens of millions of people around the world.
- 6. Ninety years ago, the UGCC told the truth about the famine to the world community. Similarly, today, the UGCC, together with the AUCCRO, appeals to the world to support Ukraine in its confrontation against the same enemy.
- 7. Moscow uses grain as a weapon to take hostages and deliberately instill apprehension among needy peoples and lands. But we remember the words of Patriarch Lubomyr Husar of blessed memory that "the government is much more afraid of freedom in the hearts than of a hungry rebellion. Because a hungry person can be bought, but a free person can only be killed."
- 8. Ukraine did not die 90 years ago. Freedom sprouted from the seeds hidden in the palms of our brothers and sisters. No evil can destroy this harvest. Our people protect it. It is protected by humanity. It is protected by the Lord. May the memory of the innocent victims of the Holodomor Genocide be eternal. "Because of the truth, which lives in us and will be with us forever" (II John 1:2), may our Victory come as soon as possible.

GRANT UNITY OF MIND, HEART AND SOUL, O LORD TO ALL LEADERS IN PUBLIC SERVICE WITH THOSE THEY SERVE.
