Epistle: A reading from the Letter of Saint Paul to the Hebrews (Hebrews 6:13-20)

Brothers and Sisters, when God made his promise to Abraham, he swore by himself, having no one greater to swear by, and said, "I will indeed bless you, and multiply you." And so, after patient waiting, Abraham obtained what God had promised. Men swear by someone greater than themselves; an oath gives firmness to a promise and puts an end to all argument. God, wishing to give the heirs of his promise ever clearer evidence that his purpose would not change,

guaranteed it by oath, so that, by two things that are unchangeable, in which he could not lie, we have taken refuge in him might be strongly encouraged to seize the hope which is placed before us. Like a sure and firm anchor, that hope extends beyond the veil through which Jesus, our forerunner, has entered on our behalf, being made high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.

Gospel: (Mark 9:17-31)

At that time, a man in the crowd came to Jesus and said: "Teacher, I have brought my son to you because he is possessed by a mute spirit. Whenever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth and grinds his teeth and becomes rigid. Just now I asked your disciples to expel him, but they were unable to do so." He replied by saying to the crowd, "What an unbelieving lot you are! How long must I remain with you? How long can I endure you? Bring him to me." When they did so the spirit caught sight of Jesus and immediately threw the boy into convulsions. As he fell to the ground he began to roll around and foam at the mouth. Then Jesus questioned the father: "How long has this been happening to him?" "From childhood," the father replied. "Often it throws him into fire and into water. You would think it would kill him. If out of the kindness of your heart you can do anything to help us, please do!" Jesus said, "If you can? Everything is possible to a man who trusts" The boy's father immediately exclaimed, "I do believe! Help my lack of trust!" Jesus, on seeing a crowd rapidly gathering, reprimanded the unclean spirit by saying to him, "Mute and deaf spirit, I command you: Get out of him and never enter him again!" Shouting, and throwing the boy into convulsions, it came out of him; the boy became like a corpse, which caused many to say, "He is dead." But Jesus took him by the hand and helped him to his feet.

When Jesus arrived at the house his disciples began to ask him privately, "Why is it that we could not expel it?" He told them, "This kind you can drive out only by prayer."

They left that district and began a journey through Galilee, but he did not want anyone to know about it. He was teaching the disciples in this vein: "The Son of Man is going to be delivered into the hands of man who will put him to death; three days after his death he will rise."

Instead of "It is truly...": In you, Lady full of grace all creation rejoices, the world of angels and the human race. Sanctified temple, spiritual paradise, boast of virgins. God took flesh from you and became a child. He was God before the ages, He made your womb a throne and made it more encompassing then the heavens. In you, Lady full of grace all creation rejoices, glory be to to You!

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, we are inviting and encouraging our parishioners to volunteer and help Mrs. Anne Boitson, Mrs. Gloria Dudych and Ms. Oksana Makovych forming the Nominating Committee and suggest candidates for our Parish Executive Council and Committees members.

Position of an auxiliary, advisory, executive parish council officer is a blessing and wonderful opportunity to show your Christian care, honesty and respect before God and our church community, talents, knowledge, experience and care serving the best to the Almighty God in our spiritual, Christian family of the Dormition of the Mother of God Ukrainian Catholic Church in Kelowna, BC!

Parish Constitution states saying: 'The Parish Council must be representative of the faithful of the parish and of the various parishrelated organisations that exist within its boundaries. Potential members of the Parish Council should have certain basic qualifications such as a keen desire to help, as well the ability to listen, reflect, and express themselves with care.' (Chapter III, Article 1, Sections 1 and 2)

Descriptions of responsibilities and ministry (see by carefully and as honest Christian responsibly reading underlined at Our Parish Constitution, Chapter III, Articles 2, 3, 4, 5,) of each officer-member of the parish council are:

Chairperson of the Parish Council is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is responsible for drawing up the agenda; calling for, directing and chairing parish council meetings; seeing that the program of activities decided upon and ratified by the pastor are implemented; is a signing officer, an ex-officio member of all parish committees. He/She prepares the chairperson's report for presentation at the AGM.

Vice-Chairperson is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is presiding at the all Parish Council Meetings in the absence of the Chairperson; carrying out such duties as are assigned by the Parish Council, the Chairperson or Pastor.

Recording Secretary is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is keeping the minutes of all Parish Council Meetings; together with the Pastor and the Chairperson signs the adopted minutes of the Council.

Treasurer is elected at the Annual General Meeting. He/She is greatly helping the financial secretary to monitor all funds received by the parish and ensure that all such funds are deposited in the parish bank account; keeping accurate records of all income and expenditures (paying all invoices-bills and reimbursements); keeps in in order and preserves documents, records and books of parish finances. He/She is a signing officer, together with the pastor, for property approved financial transactions.

It is also very important, vibrant and vital for our Christian community-family to have active and carrying representatives (a

leader and helpers) at different Parish Committees such as: Liturgical, Spiritual Care, Educational, Children Ministry, Youth Ministry, Senior Ministry, Decoration / Beautification, Maintenance, Social / Public Relations, Parish Polices Updates and Procedures.



UGCC Head on the Annunciation: Peace Comes Through from the Reconciliation of a Person with God

"Today, on the feast of the Annunciation, as we experience a very precarious moment in the history of Ukraine, I call on all our people to a nationwide reconciliation with God... During Lent, the Church calls each of us to the Holy Sacrament of Confession." The Father and Head of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church emphasized this during his sermon on the Feast of the Annunciation.

On March 25, the day of the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, His Beatitude Sviatoslav presided over the Divine Liturgy in the Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Warsaw, Poland.

"Today, I am especially privileged to come to you from Kyiv and convey to you the wounds of your Mother Church which is not yet conquered, but cares for you and embraces you," the Primate addressed

the faithful of the UGCC in Warsaw. He emphasized that Ukraine, although going through difficult times, "is fighting, it is vibrant, it is standing."

The Feast of the Annunciation, according to the Head of the UGCC, is the beginning of the salvation of mankind and a vital moment in the Christian calendar: "This is the feast of the good news, which marked the beginning of our salvation," said His Beatitude Sviatoslav, recalling the historic occasion when the Archangel Gabriel announced to the Blessed Virgin Mary that she would become the Mother of the Son of God.

The Patriarch emphasized that the event in Nazareth constitutes a sacrament of God's humility.

His Beatitude Sviatoslav drew special attention to the words of Mary: "I am the

tion to the words of Mary: "I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." (Luke 1:38). He explained that these words mean a lot to every Christian, because they contain the key to understanding how a person should regard God—with humility and willingness to fulfil His will.

Moreover, the Primate emphasized that through these two exemplars of humility— God's and humanity's—open the door to reconciliation. According to him, through God's humility, as God becomes a man, humanity is able to reconcile with God.


"That is why we are so happy today. During such a demanding, strict time of Lent, we receive a glimpse of heavenly light and joy," said His Beatitude Sviatoslav, and continued: "This is the holiday in which the beginning of our salvation is found."

The Head of the UGCC emphasized that reconciliation with God is especially pivotal for Ukrainians in times of war. "Peace stems from reconciliation between a person and God."

"To feel today how the Holy Spirit descends on us through the mediation of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the power of the Almighty envelops us, we must be reconciled with God in the Holy Sacrament of Confession," the Primate emphasized, "Because once a person says to God, 'Here I am, the Lord's servant, let it happen to me according to your word,' then the power of God becomes active and real."

"It is impossible to discover a formula for peace unless truth and justice are confronted. A person has nowhere to get that peace if they are not reconciled with God," said His Beatitude Sviatoslav.




