

Liturgical propers in English language:

Kontakion, (tone 2): O prophet and seer of the mighty works of our God,* Elias greatly renowned,* by your word, you stopped the rain clouds.* Pray for us to the only one who loves mankind.\

Prokeimenon (tone 5): You, O Lord, will guard us and will keep us* from this generation and for ever.

Verse: Save me, O Lord, for there is no longer left a just man. (Psalm 11:8,2)

Prokeimenon (tone 4): You are a priest for ever according to the order of Melchizedek.

Epistle: Romans 12:6-14; & James 5:10-20

Gospel: Matthew 9:1-8; Luke 4:22-30

At that time, when Jesus got into a boat he crossed the sea and came to his own town. And just then some people were carrying a paralyzed man lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, son; your sins are forgiven." Then some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, perceiving their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Stand up and walk'? But so that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he then said to the paralytic—"Stand up, take your bed and go to your home." And he stood up and went to his home. When the crowds saw it, they were filled with awe, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to human beings.

Your pastor may have no other way of knowing that you are in hospital, as privacy legislation.

SPIRIT OF CHRISTIAN AWARENESS: *Dear parishioners, if our brother or sister in Christ, who usually sits next to you, is not in the Church today, please phone him / her and ask how he / she is doing. Let him or her know that our parish community misses his or her at the church very much and prays for them daily! We also pray for the people of Ukraine, that with the help of the Holy Spirit, they may obtain social peace, political harmony and economic stability: Lord, hear us and have mercy.*

Basic Guidelines for Reception of Holy Communion: 1) You are a member of the Catholic Church (faithful of the Orthodox churches are very welcome to receive Holy Communion); 2) You have participated in the Sacrament of Confession at least during the Easter or Christmas seasons this past year if not more frequently; 3) You attend Divine Services regularly; 4) Your lifestyle is consistent with the teaching of the Catholic Church; 5) You have kept the Liturgical fast – no food at least one hour prior to the Divine Liturgy (water and medicine does not break the fast). 6) You have been in church from the beginning of the service, or at least heard the Gospel. 7) To the best of your ability, you are in the state of Grace. *If for any of these or other reasons you cannot receive Holy Communion, you are very welcome to come for a blessing. Please indicate to the priest that you would like to receive his blessing.*

Pastoral and Sacramental Ministry: **Baptisms:** by appointment. **Marriages:** six months' notice should be given to the parish priest, and he should be contacted before any other arrangements are made. **Reconciliation:** by appointment. **Holy Communion:** for the sick, by appointment, any time. **Holy Unction** (Anointing of the Sick): Those anticipating surgery, hospitalization or treatments and who would like to receive anointing (by appointment, any time). **Funerals and Memorials:** by appointment.




Церква святого пророка Іллі

З давніх часів у с. Оліві була дерев'яна церква святого пророка Іллі. Досі збереглося на престольне Євангеліє, датоване 1690 р. із зображенням пророка Іллі на звороті. Біля церкви містився греко-католицький цвинтар. До наших днів дійшов кам'яний хрест XVI ст. із нерозбірливим написом кирилицею та кілька хрестів початку XIX ст. З плином часу дерев'яний храм замінили на мурований (близько 1914 р.). Він втратив своє центральне місце для греко-католицької громади села і став прицвинтарною церквою для заупокійних богослужінь. Хоча в селі і постав у 1870 р. новий храм св. о. Миколая, але і в «церковці Іллі», як її ласкаво називають мешканці села, донині відправляють молебні та інші богослужіння, а на свято пророка Іллі (2 серпня) завжди є велелюдний празник.

The old-time wooden Church of Prophet Elijah used to be in Oliiv. There is still the extant altar Gospel dated 1690 with the image of Prophet Elijah on the reverse. Near the church there was a Greek Catholic cemetery. A stone cross of the 16th century bearing an illegible Cyrillic inscription and a few crosses of the early 19th century have survived. The wooden church was in time replaced by a brick one (approximately in 1914). It lost its importance for the Greek Catholic community and became a cemeterial church for burial services. Although the new St. Nicolas Church was erected in 1870, services of intercession and other services are still held in "the Elijah's Churchlet" (as the villagers tenderly call it) and on August 2 the Prophet Elijah's Day is always celebrated in a big way.




